
Lochmere Baronial Book Page 8

some expressed valid concerns,
the general consensus was to
pursue the matter. On the
29th of February, the people
of **Myrkewood** and **Arindale**
met to discuss the formation
of a barony from the the two
shires. The meeting was held
by the **Peoples Revolutionary**
Cabal, a name jokingly given
to anyone who had been helping,
but primarily to **Lady Keilyn**,
Lady Marennia, and to myself,
Lord Ilarion. After much

concern was voiced about not losing the history and the traditions of the groups, it was decided to form a barony. 

During the next month, plans were made for polling the populace and for forming the barony. The seneschals combined the business meetings, to keep the people informed. The two chroniclers, **Lady Dierdre of Cres** and myself, combined the newsletters to form the **Joint Newsletter**. This was to be the



name used until the barony
chose a more appropriate name
to suit the baronial newsletter.

On the 16th of April, the shires
of **Arndale** and **Myrkwood**
jointly sponsored an event
called the **Dragon's Journey**.
At this event, Their Majesties
awarded Arms to members
of the two shires. These
gentles were **Galmr Ingolfson**,
Cristian Darmody, and to
Dougal MacLaytt.

 - o Supplied period rhinoceros documentation to support Alric's badge.

Battle on the Bay

Missive from the Marshal in Charge - Sir Aelfred of Cres

Battle of the Bay 2015: Samkeppni Ernir (Competition of Eagles)

Battle of the Bay for 2015: Samkppni Ernir, is composed of six combined competitions designed to challenge the most puissant of warriors; skilled archers; and astute thinkers. This year's event consists of a tournament of six parts, with the winner being the contestant who fares the best over all.

Two parts are designed to challenge the mind; a series of heraldry and chess puzzles to be pondered over and submitted for consideration by the panel of judges. (You may only bring your innate knowledge to this challenge.) Two competitions to challenge the hand/eye coordination of our archers; one in target archery, the other in combat archery. Finally, two parts to challenge the warrior (heavy and rapier); a warlord tourney where honor and renown will be earned by the victorious captain.

Points will be awarded for successfully competing in each of the six parts and summed up at the end of the day. A winner will be announced for each of the six parts as well as the overall champion.

Specifics

Heraldry will consist of a series of devices, in increasing degree of difficulty and value. The contestant, using nothing more than his own knowledge of heraldry is to blazon them to the best of his ability. The panel of heralds will judge the correctness of each submission and award points accordingly.

Chess will consist of a series of puzzles that will have only one solution. Again the degree of difficulty and value will increase. The maximum number of points will be earned by the contestant who correctly solves the most puzzles.

Archery is being organized by Lord Cameron de Grey and information will be forwarded as soon as it is available.

Heavy and Rapier warlord tourney is the standard format.

It is not just Trial by Fire but Challenge of the Gods! Come Join Brighthills for an Epic Labor Day Weekend! Help us celebrate Labor Day weekend, Friday night we will kick the weekend off with a Barbecue feast and, Saturday will be a trifecta of activities first is Trial by Fire: the traditional Bright Hills cooking competition sponsored by the renowned Bright Hills Cooks' Guild. The Cooks' Guild usually cooks as a team, so the Trial By Fire competition allows cooks to showcase their individual talents. All cooks are invited to join us in demonstrating that cooking really is a spectator sport! The Second this year's Baron's Challenge is a double header with the theme of Cheese!! There will be two categories best made cheese and best dish made with cheese, may the Cheesiest win! And thirdly since we are on one of the nicest archery ranges we will be hosting this year's Lochmere Arrow shoot as well as other archery contests. We will have a Heavy marshal on site so if a heavy bear pit tournament spontaneously erupts in a back field we are ready for it!

Arts & Sciences Activities: "What's Cookin'" - Let's do a fun poem about "What's Cookin'" in your SCA fire. Let's throw caution to the wind and you do not have to document that your style is medieval. That opens up the world! You can give them to Lady Katarzyna Witkowska at Trial by Fire or email them to her at Poeta[AT]atlantia.sca.org Children will also have a full day, Lady Katarzyna Witkowska will be preparing spice rubs to take home as part of an "Herbs used in Cooking" class and we will have a "Spike" pool noodle Jousting competition for stuffed animals as well. There will also be costume contests, with prizes for best Greek garb for adults and for children, and Contests for singers, storytellers, dancers, poets, musicians and performers of all kinds, with special prizes for performances honoring Hera (from whose Island cheese cake was created) and Apollo, the harper of the gods.

Lady Yseulte invites performers of all kinds, to exercise their skills in honor of the residents of Mount Olympus, in the taverna during the day and around the campfire both Friday and Saturday evenings. She offers prizes for:

1. the largest number of different period performances about one or more of the Greek Pantheon;
2. the best original performance in honor of one or more Olympians; and
3. for performances specifically honoring:
 - a. Apollo, the archer of Olympus;
 - b. Artemis, his twin sister and Lady of the Hunt;
 - c. Arisaaios, a son of Apollo, whose name means most excellent, and who is the patron deity of shepherds, cheese- makers, beekeepers, and mead brewers; and
 - d. The victory at Marathon, (believed to have taken place on September 12), and which the Greeks credited to the intervention of Apollo and Artemis.
