As the winter snows come and cabin fever begins to set in, fear not. Their Excellencies, Baron Barre and Baroness Cordelia, will be leaving the cold and damp behind to travel to the fair lands of al-Andalus. They invite one and all to join them on this adventure.

Take a class on Mid-Eastern Dance and later display your skills in the team dance competition (each team must contain at least 1 member of the opposite sex). Other competitions include a chess tourney (3 age groups: 12 and under; 13-17; and adult); Archery from horseback. And of course an Arts and Science competition and display highlighting needlework, jewelry, illumination, poetry and scientific devices of al-Andalus (this includes Christian/Spanish and Jewish). In keeping with the Andalusian theme, the presentation of the dishes will not be in the standard remove format. They will be served singularly and in 'mini' removes. 
