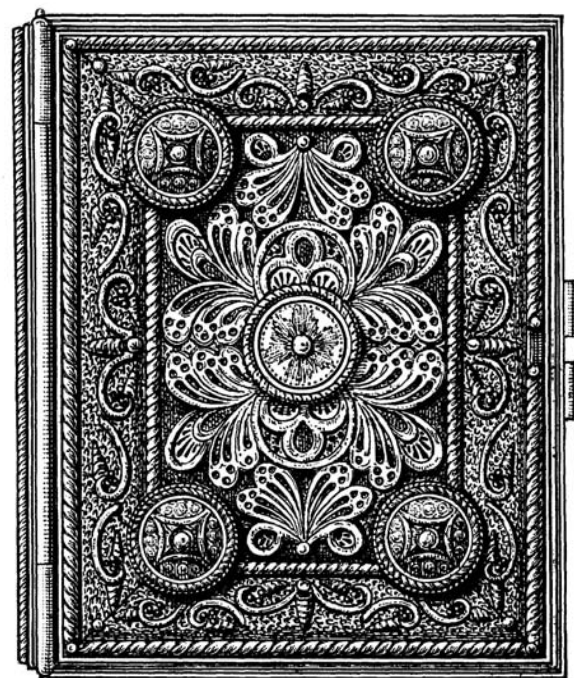

As the winter snows come and cabin fever begins to set in, fear not. Their Excellencies, Baron Barre and Baroness Cordelia, will be leaving the cold and damp behind to travel to the fair lands of al-Andalus. They invite one and all to join them on this adventure.

Take a class on Mid-Eastern Dance and later display your skills in the team dance competition (each team must contain at least 1 member of the opposite sex). Other competitions include a chess tourney (3 age groups: 12 and under; 13-17; and adult); Archery from horseback. And of course an Arts and Science competition and display highlighting needlework, jewelry, illumination, poetry and scientific devices of al-Andalus (this includes Christian/Spanish and Jewish). Documentation is always a plus. Or spend time relaxing at the gaming table or visiting the merchant's quarter.

Children's activities will include making a beaded necklace, decorating a shield and other age appropriate crafts. Children will also be invited to participate in a dramatic rendering of a song/poem.

Martial Activities will take place provided the weather and ground conditions permit outdoor activities (to include heavy, rapier, archery and thrown weapons). The marshal for each activity will make the final decision.

The feast will be prepared by the renowned Bright Hills Cook.s Guild and will feature selections from A 13th Century Andalusian Cookbook (anonymous) as well as other period dishes. In keeping with the Andalusian theme, the presentation of the dishes will not be in the standard remove format. They will be served singularly and in 'mini' removes. 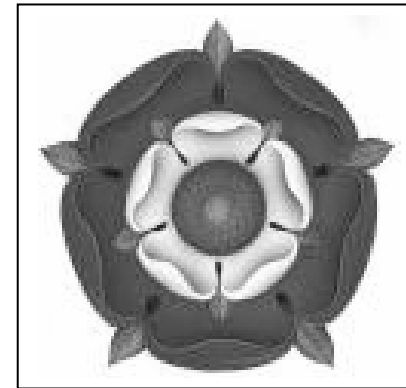

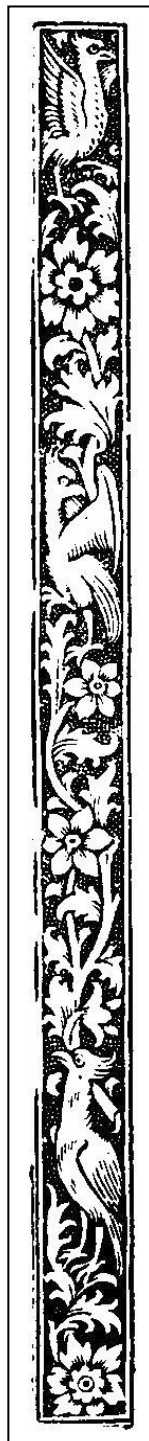

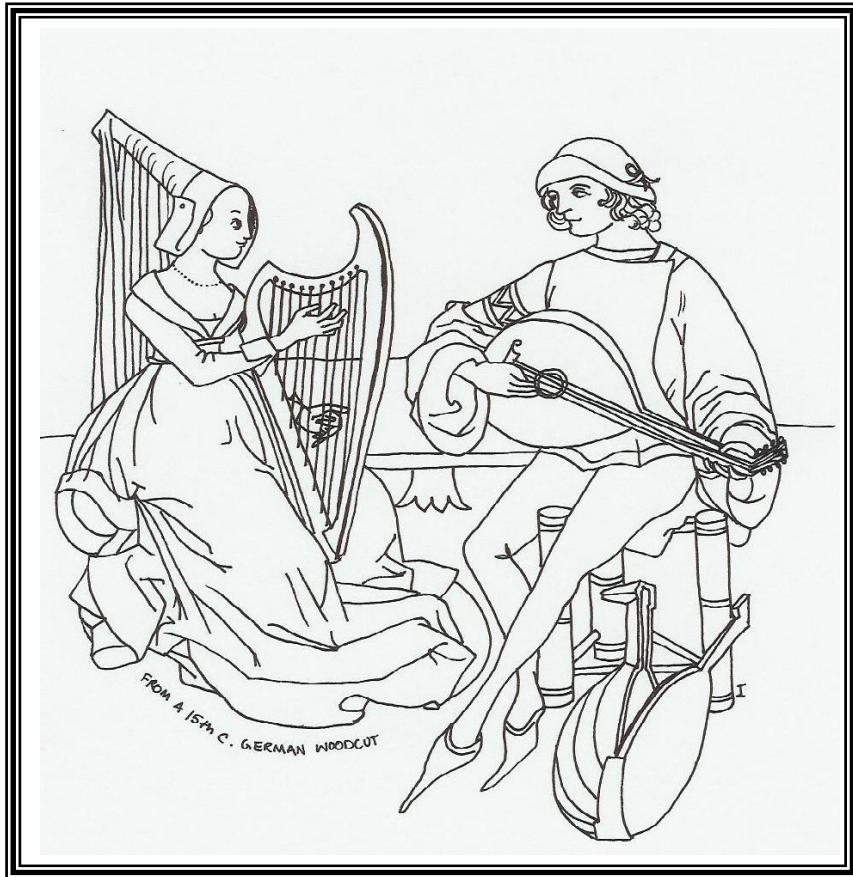
