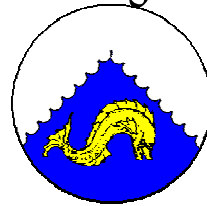

Happy New Year to all Lochmere from Lord Mikhail, Chronicler, and Lady Margery, Deputy Chronicler.

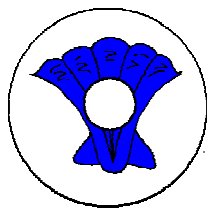
Congratulations to Lady Rita of Lochmere, who received her AoA at Revel Without a Cause.
