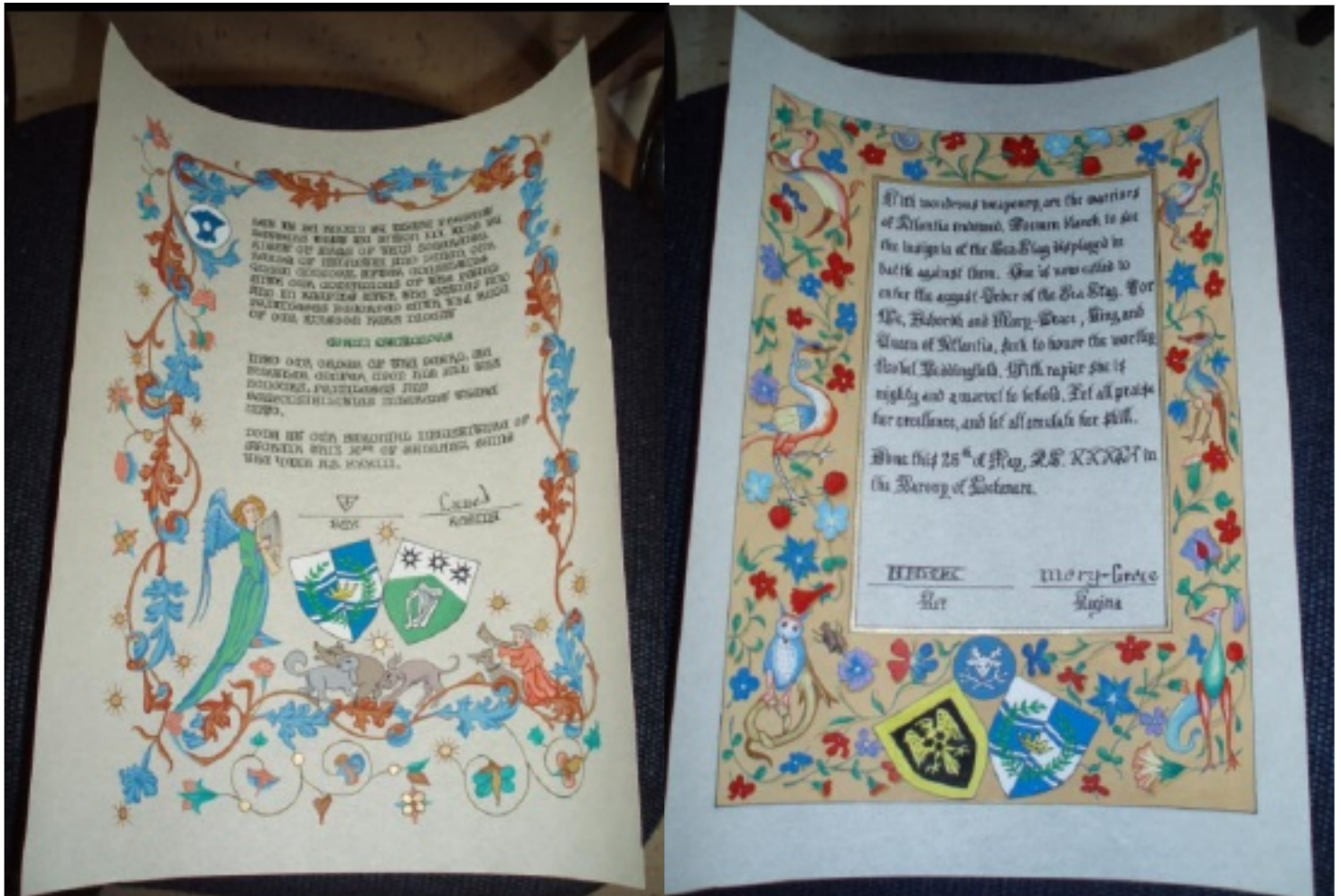

Meeting Minutes

February Business Meeting, 4 February 2008

Old Business

Midwinters report came via email.

NOTT: "Lotsa stuff." Everything set as far as food. His Excellency is cooking lunch, and will need help. Help is also needed orchestrating setup/decoration and takedown. The site is available Friday through Sunday, so Friday night setup is possible, and the cabins will be open. Baronial pavilions will be picked up from Reynard & setup. House Blackspear has offered assistance. Bardic is a possibility for around the bonfire area. Email Gabriel to volunteer (a sign-up sheet will be available at the next Business Meeting). Feast cook help has been found, but serving and cleanup help is needed and welcome. The Feast menu has been posted online; a menu should be available at each table. A volunteer for children's activities is needed. The event has been Spiked, and should be in March Acorn.

On Target: The contract has been approved. Working on event announcement (by end of week) for Acorn ASAP. Feast is being taken care of by the Bright Hills Cook Guild; lunch will probably be as well (lunch cost figured into site fee). The volunteer request will go out on the List shortly. This is a big site, so many volunteers are needed to help with setup, etc. The event is 31 May (the weekend after Memorial Day). An A&S Display is being contemplated, unless someone wants to organize a competition (contact Aeddán).

Baronial Birthday: CC will be cooking. Basic flyer should be put together by end of week for the Acorn, to prevent conflicts. A Heavy Marshal will be "borrowed" from Bright Hills; a modified Bedford Points Heavy Tournament is planned.

Due to 'hiccups' in the Spike electronic setup, if you Spike an event and later make changes, email the Chronicler (Kingdom) to notify them of the changes.

New Business

A new home is sought for Cook's Guild equipment (not with Vlad & Medb). (This leads back to the storage unit issue, for discussion later.)

Pennsic: Lochmere camp has been registered. When you pre-reg, please let Reynard know: who is registering (real people & ghosts), size of your pavilion (including poles & ropes). If you're unsure about the latter, contact Reynard prior to registering, to find out how much space you'll need.

Misha has volunteered to autocrat Midwinter's 2009. Eibhlin has volunteered to cook. Further volunteering opportunities will come available as Misha more fully realizes just what he's gotten himself into.

Duchess Simone has forwarded a list of Kingdom Events that need bids. The list includes:

Officer Reports

B&B: Thanks to everyone who worked hard at Midwinters, "had a good time" comments were heard. Kingdom A&S is coming up, and a Baronial representative is requested; the representative will be asked to judge 3 other entries, not necessarily in their area of expertise. Coronation: Their Highnesses came up with an idea similar to Coronation last year, with a Quest theme; the Baronies have each been asked to provide someone to manage a station; details are online.

Exchequer: \$9218.57 in account. At Midwinter's '08, 85 visitors, ¼ of whom were non-members. \$1422 was taken in at gate. Expenses about \$200 less, total take \$199 and change.

Chatelaine: Eibhlin's warrant finalized, NTR otherwise.

A&S: A&S/Newcomer's at Alfred & Simone's. Next will be Feb 25. Teachers sought. Brewing is scheduled at Misha's on 9 February and 9 March. Cheesemaking Weekend is scheduled for after KASF with Eibhlin. People are welcome to stop by for either.

Heavy Marshal: No practice 12 February due to Primaries. 18 March will be no practice because schools will be closed. Quarterly waiver report submitted.

Archery: Still too cold to shoot. March 13 is DST, our usual 'start-up' time. Practice is still possible before the with sufficient advance notice to Aeddán.
