Meeting Minutes - August 2008

Old Business

Polling: If it wasn't postmarked by Saturday the 12th of July, it's too late.

Baronial Birthday: Invitations have been made for previous Barons & Baronesses, as well as personal invites for TRMs and the Royalty from the formation of the Barony. A sign-up list for the event is going around. Another request for pictures, etc, from the history (digital is fine, Aelfred will scan) has been made--if you've anything, please let Alfred know. An A&S Display is being run by Arianna with the theme: "20 Years of Excellence in A&S" Categories: Laurels, Pearls, Coral Branch, Nautilus, etc. (show the item that 'earned' you the award; you don't have to make anything new). Also, Jack-of-all-Trades competition sponsored by Arianna. Vitha would like to sponsor a Youth competition. Reservations are being accepted by Duchess Simone.

Midwinter's: The event has been Spiked. The contract is in hand, and if Misha had been less addle-headed, it would have been brought to the meeting. The event's theme is: "A Gathering of Guilds." Potential 'Guildmasters' for the various 'Guilds' have been contacted. A budget is being worked up. Things are moving apace.

Pennsic: The truck has been reserved, at a cost of \$50/head for reimbursement. The plan is to ask the Financial Committee to OK the Barony covering half of the truck costs. (The Committee was asked, the motion made, seconded, voted on, and passed). This brings the cost down to ~\$25/head for reimbursement. If you are staging stuff at Dee's, please make sure it's well labeled (poles especially; markings of "1 of 2," etc.) to avoid confusion. A list for Royal Encampment Guard Duty positions is going around; Monday of War Week is proposed for the duty day. Gift baskets for Trimaris have been asked about (Misha volunteered a bottle or two of wine), contact Sharon Henderson (info @ Mary Rose). The Camp Steward has everything needed for the camp plan. Truck loading will take place ~4pm at Dealla's on the 24th.

On Target 2009: Reynard is on for Autocrat, arrangements will be made.

NOTT 2009: Duchess Simone has volunteered to autocrat.

New Business

Reynard would like to change poles on the 30' Baronial pavilion and get 7' walls. The price will be investigated.

B&B: Thanks from the Storvik Autocrat for those who helped set up. Storvik was very appreciative of the assistance. It was good practice for Pennsic. Congrats to Misha for his Pearl. We look forward to seeing everybody who can make it to Pennsic there, otherwise at the Baronial Birthday, otherwise we'll have to crack some heads.

Exchequer: We have \$11525.12 in the accounts after 2 good events. We are set for everything currently being worked on.

Chatelaine: Last month's newcomers had ~10 people. 3 contacts this month, 2 of whom are already participating in SCA, just new to the area. The Chatelaine 101 class was covered at Storvik. July Newcomer's Night is cancelled, due to Pennsic Prep.

Youth Minister: NTR this week.
