Meeting Minutes - February 2009

Old Business

Midwinter's: The event was good. Final head-count was around 75-ish. Many teachers, performers, presenters came to provide of their knowledge; a good time was had by all. Rita was chosen as new A&S Champion. Baron Aelfgar was picked as 'People's Choice'. We got the check back from the Site; all told, the site cost us \$100. Contact info for 'Guild-Heads' will go in the Dredgings. Tons of help was provided to the Kitchen, and it was greatly appreciated.

On Target 2009: The contract has been placed 'Somewhere Safe.' The event has been Spiked. A copy will be coming in to Padre for signature. The event is to take place on the last Saturday in May. Pending confirmation from the Financial Committee, the event fee will be \$8/head.

NOTT 2009: Moved to/combined with Baronial Birthday.

Baronial Birthday 2009: Reservation is for last weekend in September. We have been asked to consider changing the date (issue with conflict of Chalice of the Sun God, Siege of Glengarry). Duchess Simone will call in to the Site to see when/if/what other weekends are available.

The Barony still 'owns' 23 KWAR T-shirts, 154 Lochmere Vocal Music Group CDs. It was proposed that we sell them, \$100 for all, if we can find a buyer. Motion to sell made, seconded, carried. A buyer to be looked for. (Found—Padre bought them, donated them to the Baronial Gift Basket collection.)

B&B: Thanks for hard work (especially with unexpected conditions) at GoG. Many compliments. Congrats to everybody. Baronial/Baroness' progress is on Website. March: Kingdom A&S. February: Bright Hills on 14th, Ponte Alto's on 28th.

Exchequer: Sir Alfred new as of Event. Currently \$11292.84 in assets. Check to be deposited from GoG. New volunteer for Financial Committee needed. Volunteers accepted, or some folks will be asked. Vlad & Mistress Aryanna volunteer. Put to a vote: Vlad new FC member. New group policy review checklist just came in; financial policy to be reviewed & updated shortly. There are questions regarding On Target financials/budget request. Profit margin built in?

Chatelaine: At GoG, there were a couple formerly from Drachenwald, as well as a couple of others (inactive for a while). Several other contacts being followed up on. Partial tabards were found in the loaner garb... Tabard sewing to be done at an upcoming A&S night?

Webminister: All awards through Midwinters are updated. Court reports also. Corrected names, updated positions, etc. Needs Baroness Dealla & Lady Christiana permission for contact info to be posted on web. In future, requirement that all contact info beyond SCA name/email be approved in writing (email sufficient).
