Old Business

Reports

B&B: We went to KASF; the Barony had a good showing. Lord Arghylle won the Heart of Atlantia with his (incredibly!) carved chair. Mistress Aryanna had a very nice music display; she was in the top 4 of a very close competition. Lady Lisette, Lady Rita, and Mistress Sigrid also had very nice displays. It was quite crowded, and full of lots to see! We won't be making many events for a couple of months, although Coronation is a possibility. If the populace has any particular opinions on a Baronial Bard position, please express them on the Yahoo! group, or to Their Excellencies.

Exchequer: The Bad News is that we may have a \$1000 debt coming up (there have been no payments for the Fighter Practice site since June 2007). We're hoping they'll waive the last fiscal year's bill, but our breath is not being held. A fundraiser at the September Event is a possibility; the Financial Committee will be consulted. The Good News is that as of February 27, we have \$11375.92 in the bank, and the statement came to the correct Exchequer (who also received his warrant). The Gathering of the Guilds made \$399 profit.
