The Barony of Lochmere Business Meeting was held at the Severna Park Library, at 7:15 p.m., November 7th.

Officer's reports:

Exchequer: Sir Aelfred informed the group that as of 31 October, there is \$10,593.79 in the account. There will be a \$2.00 service charge each month. There was discussion recently to hold the A&S Combo an additional night each month. After discussion it was agreed that the Combo night will be the 2nd and 4th Tuesday of each month. The 3rd quarter report will be sent as soon as the Exchequer obtains the Seneschals' signature. The proposed financial policy will be posted to the list once it has been reviewed and put to a vote at the December meeting.

MoAS: The October Combo Night went very well, had fun with painting banners. Lisette is looking for people to do classes for Combo nights; please contact her. She would like some classes to focus on late 16th century if possible, maybe clothing — to gear up for Night Under the Town, however, all classes are welcome and appreciated.

A&S for Midwinters has been announced in the Acorn and is updated online. Lisette is hoping to get classes, has received some contacts. Bags will be made for the bag game at the next Combo night in November, please bring a sewing machine if you would like to assist with making the bags.
