## Living by the Book: Monks, Nuns and Their Manuscripts

Saturday, July 13, 2013–Sunday, September 29, 2013

Time 10:00 AM–05:00 PM on Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday, Sunday

Today, medieval books are treated as works of art, untouchable treasures to be locked away in cabinets. Yet many were intended for regular use as vital components of everyday life for monks and nuns, and their way of life was, in turn, crucial for the creation and preservation of manuscripts. In the vibrant culture of the monastic community, new and innovative devotional texts and images were created, while secular knowledge, including music, history, science, grammar and classical literature, was also actively enjoyed and preserved. This exhibition, of approximately 20 books, will explore the life of the monastery as told through the variety of books that were created, used, cherished, glossed, worn down and palimpsested by those who lived there over the centuries.

## **Hastilude at the Hollow II**

August 29-September 02, 2013

Barony of Black Diamond

---

Come, bring your horses and do all things equestrian for four days! Beginning on Thursday, 29 August, and running through Monday, 2 September 2013. The Hastilude will include equestrian challenge courses, mounted archery, mounted combat training, SCA foam jousting and wooden lance jousting, an Inter Kingdom Equestrian Competition, double elimination match games, birjas, spear throwing, pig-sticking/tent-pegging, quintain, other games, trail rides, an mounted "hunt", and all the riding and equestrian practice you want.

Start and finish each day with a fine meal by Master Robear and celebrate with song and story each evening around the fire ring.

**IMPORTANT:** In order to fully participate in all the activities, each rider must have their own complete set of equestrian games equipment, including: pig-sticking lance, quintain lance, ring lance, javelin/throwing spear, sword, and birjas spear. If a rider wants to use one piece of equipment for more than one game, the rider may have to carry that piece of equipment with them on the trail. Those riders who want to participate in the mounted hunt and mounted archery must bring a bow and several arrows. Jousting should bring lances, tubes, and tips, as well as their fanciest caparisons, shields, and helm crests.

Find your best possible route to Hwy. 301 going towards La Plata, MD. Once in La Plata, turn west on MD-6 Port Tobacco Road (left if coming from points south, right if coming from points north.) Travel 11.3 miles, then turn left on Ironsides Road (MD-425S). In just over 1 mile, the road will take a sharp turn right (a church, the site for Royal Archery in May 2013, will be in front of you). Follow the sharp turn, continuing on Ironsides Road. Melwood is approximately 0.75 miles on your right.

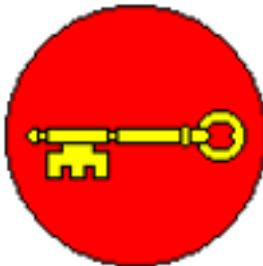

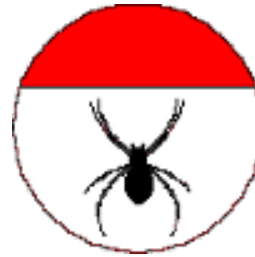
