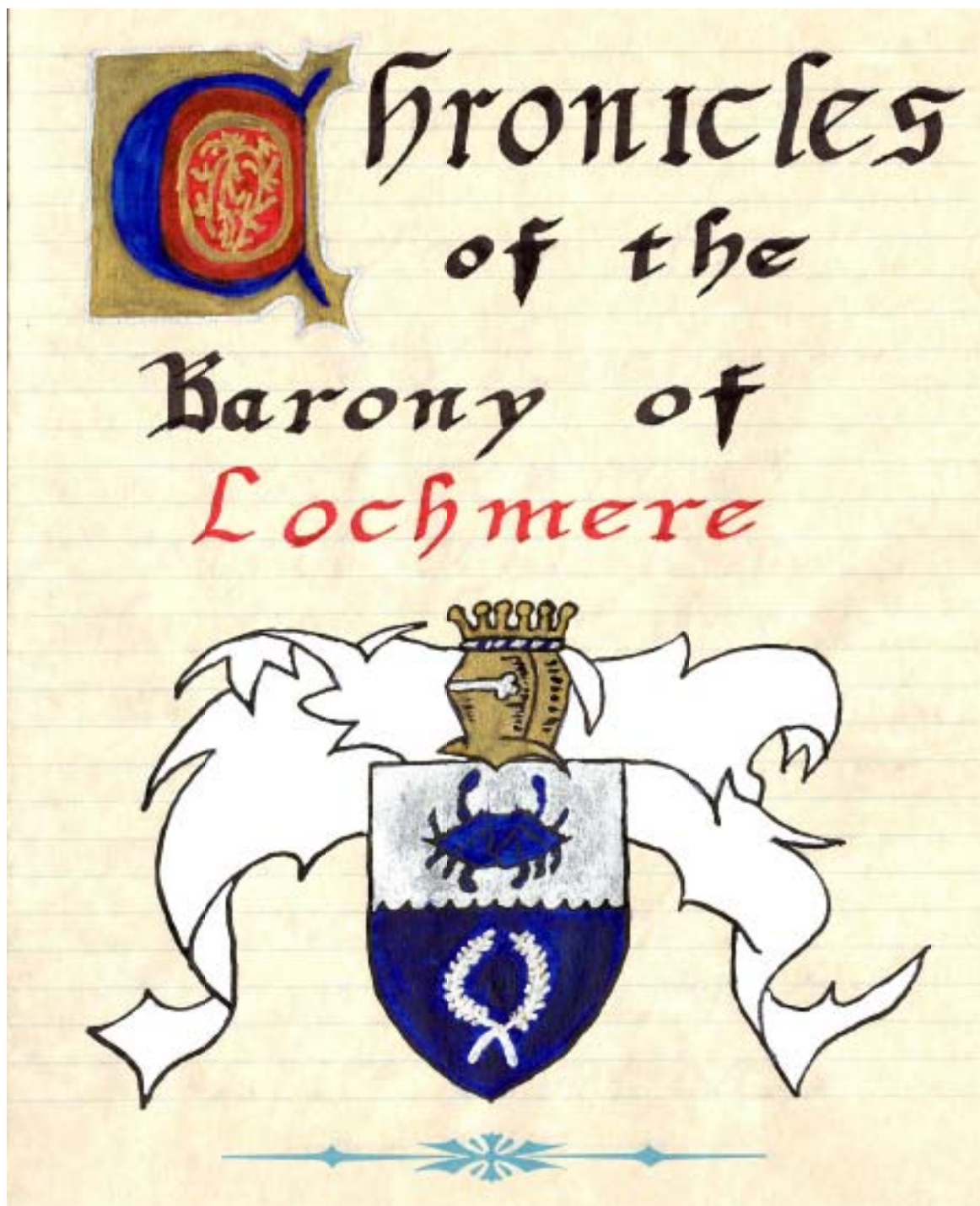

Camping with Lochmere @ Pennsic

Greetings Lochmerie:

The deadline for Pennsic pre-registration is fast approaching. If you plan to camp with Lochmere you must pre-register by the deadline which is June 17, 2015 (on-line). To pre-register, go to www.pennsicwar.org, select "Lochmere" from the drop down list.

Each paid reservation gives you 250 square feet on which to set up your pavilion/tent. If your pavilion is larger than 250 square feet, please register additional spaces accordingly. If your financial situation allows, please consider registering additional space to contribute to the common area which includes space for the Baronial pavilion (which is used as our entrance and central gathering area), our showers, fire pit, and courtyard.

Please contact our Land Agent, Master Reynard (Ernie Stuermer) at baronreynard@juno.com (with a copy to me at chrissings@juno.com) and give him the following information:

- . Pavilion foot print (shape and size) (please specify space needed for ropes)
- . Type of pavilion/tent;
- . Date of arrival; and
- . Names under which extra space has been registered.

The subject line of your e-mail should read "Pennsic Tent Info"

If you do not have a period pavilion, we may be able to arrange a loaner. Please let us know as far in advance as possible if you would to borrow a pavilion. Experienced campers will tell you that you will be far more comfortable in a period pavilion than a mundane tent. They do not get as hot as mundane tents and are usually more water-proof and spacious. As a bonus, period pavilions look spiffier!

More information will follow over the next few weeks! Stay tuned!

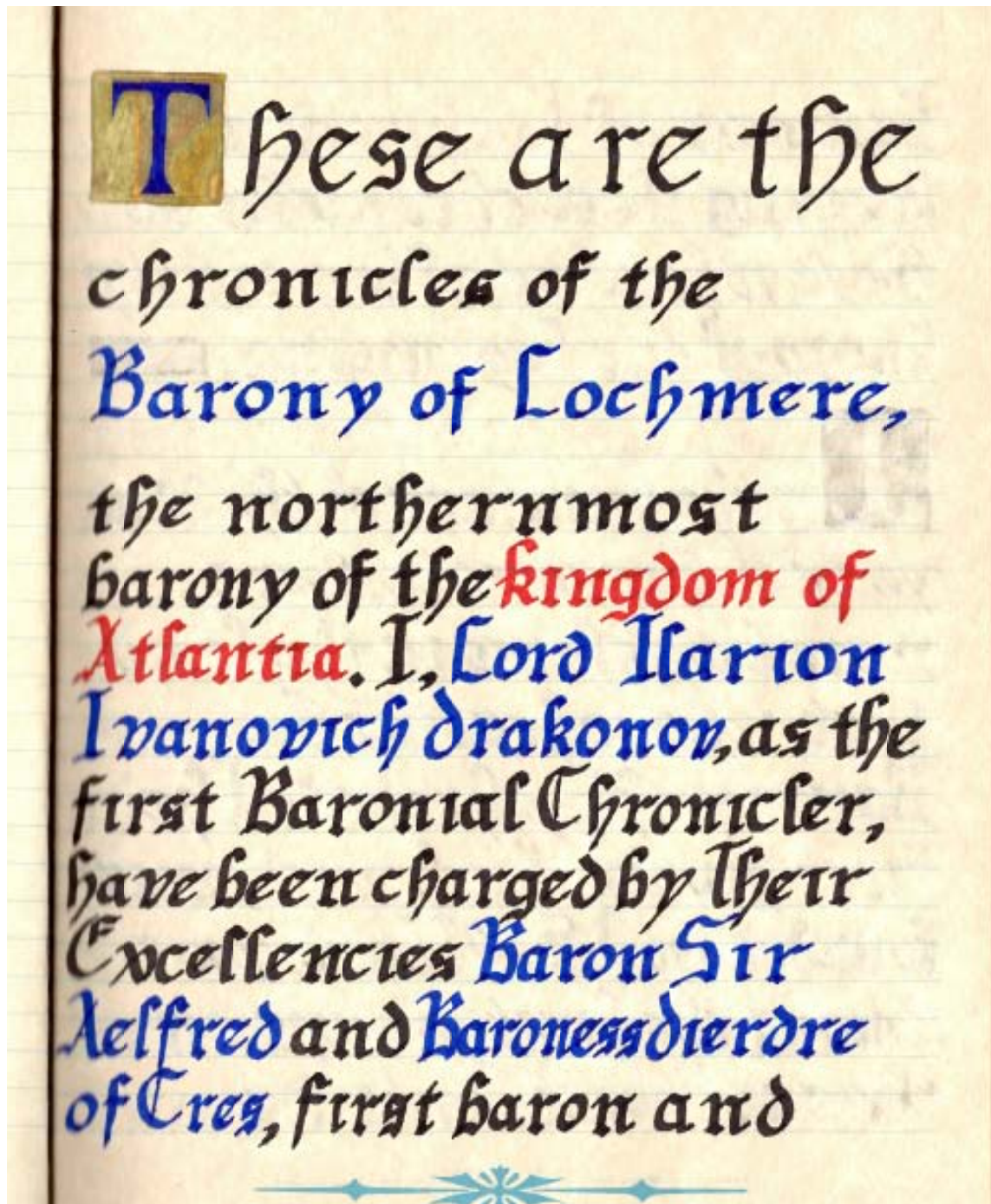
Lochmere Baronial Book Page 1

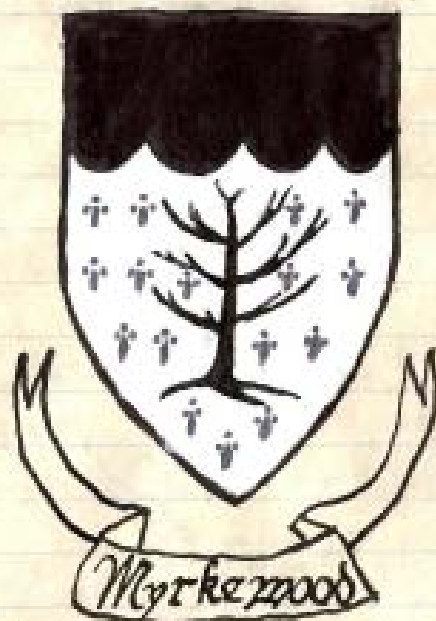

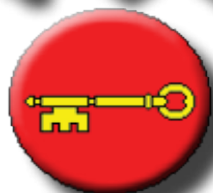
