

The baronial investiture was scheduled for the Atlantian court at the Pennsic War XVIII, on August 20, A.S. XVIII. On August 19, when Mistress Hilary, the Society Steward, was approached about our petition, she approved it on the condition that our device had been approved at the kingdom level, and that we claim only the area in Anne Arundel and Howard counties. We went to Mistress Hilary, the Atlantian

herald, to ask about our device.
She informed us that she had
not received our submission.
We spent that afternoon of
the 19th resubmitting our
device and obtaining conditional
approval of our device. This
satisfied the **Steward** and we
received approval of our petition.
Their Atlantian Majesties,
Daffyd and **Elizabeth**, were
informed and agreed to invest
Sir Xelfred and **Lady Oierdre**
on the next day at court. 



The **Atlantian** court was held between battles on the 20th. The investiture began with **Lady Marenna of Rathlin** and myself, **Lord Ilarion Ivanovich**, followed by the banners of the two groups, being called into court. We formally asked **Their Majesties** to create a barony out of our groups, to be called **Lochmere**. We asked for the people of both groups to come into court. **Their Majesties** granted our request, and asked if we had a



choice for the head of our barony.
 We asked that **Sir Aelfred** and
Lady Dierdre be invested as the
 founding **Baron** and **Baroness**
 of **Lochmere**. They were sworn
 in over earth from our lands,
 brought by the two seneschals. 

This was the beginning of our
 barony. The following is a list

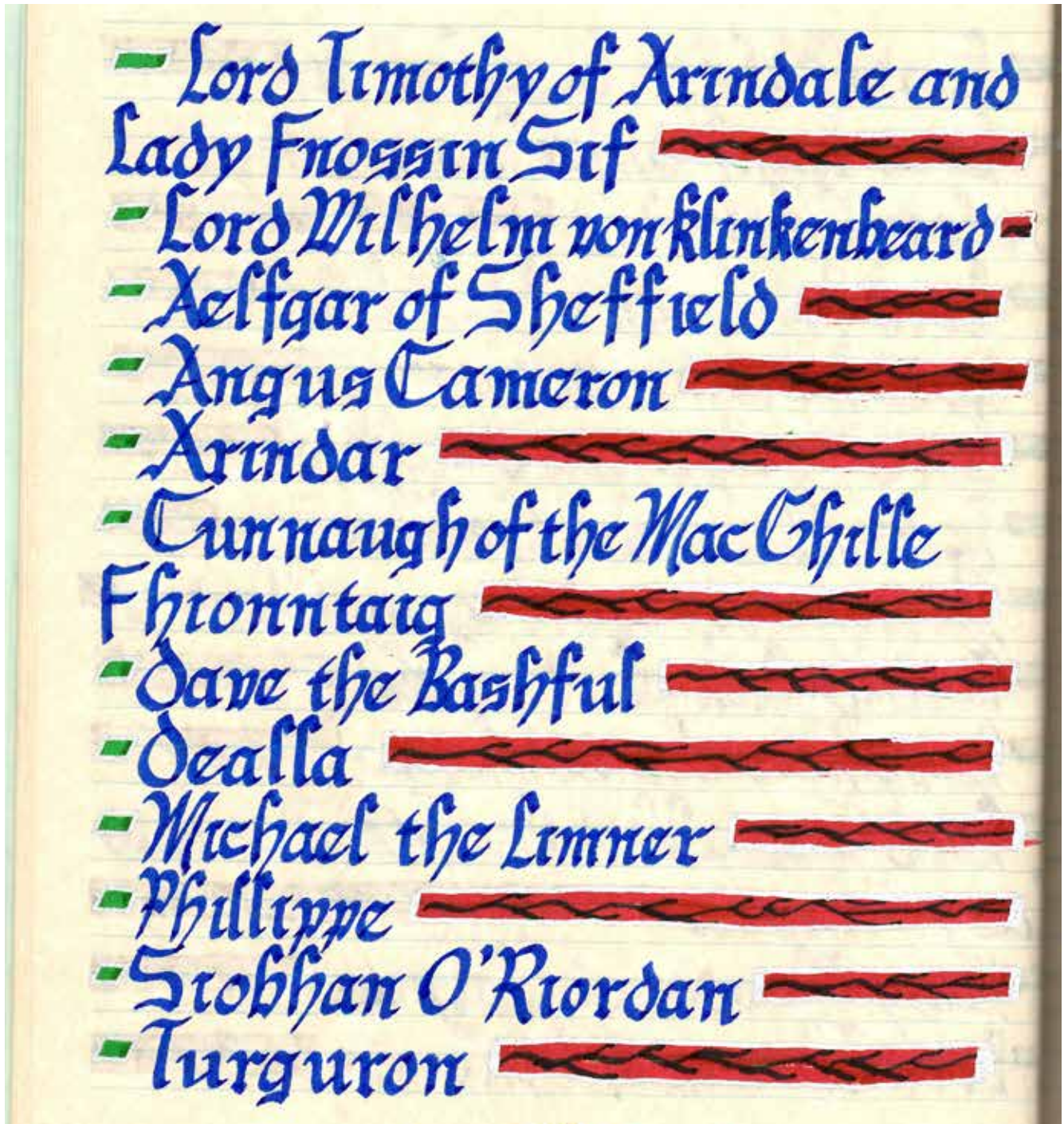
