Lochmere Business Meeting Notes

Next Meeting April 3, 2107

Baron: Been to several events, all is going well—proud of everyone and what they are doing. Spoke to church about fighter practice after June, it has indoor area for practice. It's on New Cut Road, Chris Maddox Christian Church.

Baroness: Stakes were bought for 14X14 (dayshade) but were never received them after Pensic. Also need eight ropes for it. A bag will be made to place everything into once all the parts are located. Tatiana is making bigger banner replacements. Cost of the materials need to be approved. Old banners will be retired with honors. NOTT: Serving as Royal Liaison and everything that needs to be covered is taken care of. Need to do loner armor inventory. Coronation: Serving as Generosity an Agent of Charity so please consider going and volunteering as a Virtue of Charity. As they do need help at the event itself. Scribal this Sunday, March 12th at Baroness' house and please RSVP if coming with a PM via Facebook. Don't forget to get in award recommendations in for NOTT. Loner Armor needs to be inventoried. Gwen is looking into website—we are unable to update anything to it.

Seneschal: Officers are to give their warrant status with reports, other than that not much to report at this moment—all is going smoothly. The Regional Seneschal will be handling the polling. All officers that volunteered were approved for office.

Exchequer: Warrant expires: Warrant needs to be signed and submitted to Kingdom for new exchequer Current Ledger \$15484.12. Checks mailed out that were due to Kingdom and Bright Hills. New fighter practice location delayed till June. Will send out request for liability insurance document to include new location. End of Year was sent in a week late but was in coordination with kingdom exchequer and regional exchequer to resolve how numbers were allocated. After warrant is approved is when we should coordinate new bank signatories. Received Battle on the Bay split in mail. Called and asked Midwinter site to mail our statement and copy of signed contract. No response right now. Need Budget for On Target. We have bills for two or three fighter practices I do not believe we attend, need to find out for sure, the Baroness said to check on Facebook to double check.

We are going to look into outsourcing our website. Other groups have been doing this already. It would be more efficient to have it outsourced.
