- NOTT is a royal progress —need ideas for gift basket—will be sending out invites to the new Royal Highnesses
- Will be meeting with Storvik to discuss Battle on the Bay please voice your comments and or concerns so they may be passed on.

Seneschal:

- Attended Harvest Wars and Crown, will be attending Dun Carig event and WOW
- Will also be attending Battle on the Bay meeting —will be talking about improvements, discuss concerns, etc.
 - Please send in your input to pass along at the meeting
- We have an officer position opening up —will discuss later in meeting
- Need to review warrants starting next business meeting please be prepared to report on warrant status

Chronicler:

- Newsletter was posted on November 1, 2017
- If you have photos, articles, anything that you would like to submit for the newsletter please do -1 am happy to receive and publish it-Mistress Arianna said she had something to submit

Exchequer: (emailed report)

- Ledger Balance is \$9.579.41 of which \$724.46 belongs to the Cavalry Funds. The Baronial Balance is \$8,854.95.
- The Battle on the Bay Event report is complete. The final profit was \$2,991.29, the split with Storvik is \$1,495.65. The check was delivered to Storvik at Crown Tournament on November 4th.
- Mistress Arianna has agreed to keep track of our equipment/property. Because she will not be involved with the Baronial funds, she does not need to be warranted.
- I still require a deputy, someone who is willing to be on the checking account, get warranted, can fill in for me if
 I am not available and take over the office if I am unable to continue. Scott by default is my deputy because he
 is the only other warranted exchequer. His warrant expires in Oct 2018





- Aside from a warranted deputy, I am asking for more people willing to be added as signatories on the checking account. My requirement is whomever is added should to come to business meetings, fighter practices, or other Baronial gatherings where we can meet on a regular basis in the event a check needs to be issued to Amber or myself.
- The current bank account signatories are Dawn Fuller, Frank Felix, Scott Glover, Clint Darby, Stephanie Fogle, Walter Assur, and Anthony Toich. Walter will be removed from the account once we resolve the Key Exceutive issue. I propose we remove both Stephanie and Anthony since they don't come to meetings and Scott can be removed once a new deputy is warranted. If by chance there is more than one person who would like to be a warranted deputy that is fine too.
- I sent a letter to Howard County School District regarding a refund for the over payment. I was told the credit balance was an error when they switched to a new accounting system and we owed for an unpaid balance from Sep 2016. I could not verify any payment of the invoice she said was outstanding and did not dispute the issue.

Quartermaster:

- Need to have full inventory completed by the end of the year
- If you have any Baronial gear, items, etc. please give a full account before Thanksgiving

- Trying to attract non-archers as well.


Old Business:
