Lochmere Business Meeting Notes



Baroness: (emailed report):

- Back in June, Lady Sarra (her Nexcellency) did inform Master Kryss, Gabrell, and myself that she was not going to be able to autocrat NoTT due to work concerns. A message did not go out requesting a new autocrat. I would like to take up that mantle and am by way of this message offering to do so. Master Kryss, please announce this at the meeting and open up the 2 week comment period.
- Gabrell & I will be attending Trial by Fire this weekend and University next weekend. Hope to see you all there.
- 95% of the Baronial regalia and assorted stuff have been transferred to Cormac and Sarra. The rest will be transferred at Battle on the Bay. I have done an inventory and will be providing to the Exchequer after BotB.
- Pennsic was awesome! Thank you everyone who attended for making it so.
- It has been hard to find time on the weekends to do scribal. I am looking at Sundays in October and
 November to hold the next one. Input on dates is welcome.
- Thank you Lochmere. It has been an adventure. We hope to see many of you at our Devestiture and know you will help us in welcoming Cormac and Sarra as Lochmere's new B&B.

Baron:

- Happy to see that everyone had a good time at our court at Pennsic.
- Pollings: Only 67 responses, more than 100 were sent out. Please remind people who may or may not play often and pay their dues to respond so we can hear what they have to say as well. This helps in their Majesties make a decision.
- Thank you everyone, it's been an awesome three years serving as your Baron.

Seneschal:

• The Anti-bullying policy signs have been made and laminated and they need to be posted at all events. It also has to be included in any handouts given at events. This is to be applied to all future events from here on out, policy of the SCA.





• The Exchequer has pointed out that we have had to pay for late fees twice and that's late/expediency fees for insurance. Waiting till the last minute costs an extra \$175, on top of the normal \$50. Needs to be paid at least a month in advance to avoid the late charges.

Chronicler:

September Dredgings sent out on the first, no business meeting notes but included some pictures that were
provided of the Drunken Court and also announced their new Excellencies.

Exchequer:

- Ledger Balance is \$7,672.98 of which \$596.46 belongs to the Equestrian Funds. The Baronial Balance is \$7,076.50.
- All quarterly reports are complete and turned in to the Kingdom Exchequer.
- The only open old action is the refundable deposit from Elks Camp Barret from Night on the Town. We wrote a deposit check of \$300.00 according to the site contract it is refundable unless we cause damage. The refund has not been received, I contacted Mebd who is trying to get in touch with the camp.
- When we were paying Talbot Springs Elementary School one too many payments were made. We are owed one night that we can reserve for something. Needs to be done before the end of the year while the insurance is still good.

Minister of Arts and Sciences:

- Things have been quiet with Pennsic going on, the rest of the month is crazy but should be back on track with A&S nights soon.
- Have liked doing the Sunday A&S gatherings but have also discussed doing a combined A&S with Tuesday
 night fighter practice once they move inside at the church lots of space.

Chatelain:

• Just before Pennsic we received seven points of contact and have been in contact with three. Have received back two emails — all are interested. I think right now they are excited because of Renn Faire right now, but will see/





hear from them after. They have been invited to Battle on the Bay.

Minister of Youth

- We will have children's activities as Battle on the Bay from 1-3 pm on Saturday. Looks like we are making puppets.
- Nothing else going on at the moment.

Equestrian:

- At monthly practices (held on a Sunday) it has been opened up to heavy fighters. If fighters would like to attend
 it would be a help getting the horses used to all the noise and give the fighters an extra practice if they do want to
 come out.
- It's out in Davidsonville at Stellar Riding (watch out with GPS tells you that you're there but you still have farther down the road to go).
- There will be a fundraiser lunch at Battle on the Bay -3 options ham or turkey sandwich or humus and crackers. Kind of a pack your own lunch with carrots, cookies, etc. to put in your lunch bag. \$5 recommended donation. What isn't eaten with go to cavalry and horses. Should be served around noonish.





Battle on the Bay:

- Will be on site by noon on Friday for set up site opens at 5:00 pm to the public. Will need help with set up and clean up.
- If anyone is on site Friday for set*up please check in at troll so that is taken care of sooner than later.
- Procession is at 10:00 am and Investiture Court is at 10:30 am Saturday morning.
- Not sure what time the porta-potties will be set up, but there are facilities on the grounds.
- We don't have anyone for water baring, but the stuff will be there. It will be set up in the MOL tent. Kender is MOL in charge.
- Need help Saturday morning for troll—have some volunteers already.

Mid-Winter:

- It's coming along, had to make some changes on the budget after it was submitted. Will get those changes made as soon as possible and resubmitted soon. Once approved we can move forward from there.
- Some spots still need to be filled bardic (Scholastica volunteered).
- Lissette is trying to get some drummers and dancers together for event.
- Theme is Diwali, an Indian Festival of Lights.
- Need people to teach some classes.





- Anya has volunteered to be the reservationist, Caius will be the hall steward, Lady Brynn will do gate, Lissette will cook.
- Still need to discuss A&S ideas with Greer.

Night on the Town:

- Baroness Avice has volunteered for the position of autocrat. It was voted to wave the time period and vote on the position of autocrat in order to get it spiked immediately. It was unanimous for the Baroness to take the position.
- It was spiked for 20-22 April, 2018 as a place holder. More to follow.
