Directions:

From the West: Take the best route to MD-32 to I- 97 South. From I-97 take Exit 5, MD- 178/Crownsville. At the light, continue straight on MD-178 South for approximately 1.8 miles. At the light turn right onto Crownsville Road. Continue approximately 1 mile and turn right onto Hawkins Road (there is a sign for Elks Camp Barrett). Continue for approximately 1.8 miles. At bottom of hill, go thru the stop sign to enter the camp.

From the North: Take the best route to I-97 South to Exit 5 and follow directions above for those coming west.
From the South: From the Beltway (I-495), take exit 19A US-50 East to exit 23 MD-450/Parole. Take MD-450 West and turn left at the light in front of Annapolis Mall (still MD-450). Continue approximately 2 miles. Turn right at the light onto Crownsville Road. After 0.5 miles there will be a blue sign for Elks Camp Barrett. Take a left onto Chesterfield Road and go approximately 1.4 miles. The camp will be on your left.
