Daniel liked to make his poetry obscure and is considered the creator of the sestina. Dante uses Daniel in The Divine Comedy as a character in Purgatory.

## Exchequer Tips

Financial Committee: Do you know who your Financial Committee is and what we do? In Lochmere your Financial Committee consists of the Exchequer, the Seneschal, and the Baron & Baroness. We each get one vote with the exception of the Baron & Baroness who get one vote collectively.

In order to keep the Barony running smoothly, your Financial Committee can authorize expenditures up to \$250.00 or 10% of the Barony's unallocated funds, whichever is less. In the event of an emergency, as defined by the Barony's approved Financial Policy, we can authorize up to \$3,000.00. If we do any of these things outside of a Baronial meeting, we must report it at the next populace meeting.

The Financial Committee reviews and approves event budgets and has input to the yearly operating budget before it is brought before the populace for vote.
