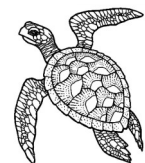
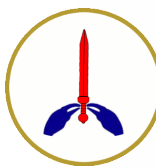
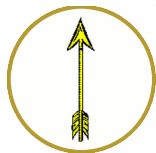

A&S Displays and Contests:

1. Open display - Suggest entrants have a notepad or 3x5 cards for comments.
2. "New to me Novice Competition" - Entries must be something you've tried for the first time in the last year.
3. "Harvest Wars Triathlon" - Must enter three items. There are five categories and you must pick three of those categories for your entries. Documentation required. Does not have to match your persona.
