Food For Thought

Farsed Eggs

One of the exciting parts of researching in period foods and recipes is finding a “modern” concept that excited pre-1600. One interesting such discovery was the “Farsed Egg.” The concept of “farsing” or “forcing” foods is not a new one and extends to other meats and dishes such as farsed crab, but the concept is the same. To Farce, you would remove one element of the focus food such as an egg (remove the yolk), season and return it to its original location (inside the whole that remains where the yolk was).



Most modern European and North American cooks and consumers know this as a “deviled egg,” but this term wasn’t coined until the 19th century. Prior to that, the concept of seasoning a hard boiled egg dates back to Ancient Rome where they were served

at the beginning of a meal. In the 13th century, the most well known recipe of a stuffed egg originated from an Andalusian 13th century cookbook. This Spanish variation pounded boiled egg yolk with cilantro, pepper, coriander, and onion juice, then mixed with a type of fermented barley or fish called “murri,” oil, and salt and returned to the center of the egg white.

Stuffed eggs in the 15th and 16th centuries, sometimes referred to as Farced Eggs, became popular. They mixed not only similar ingredients that were typically found in English gardens such as parsley, mint, and savory but also mixed in spices and ingredients that were sweeter, such as nutmeg and raisins.

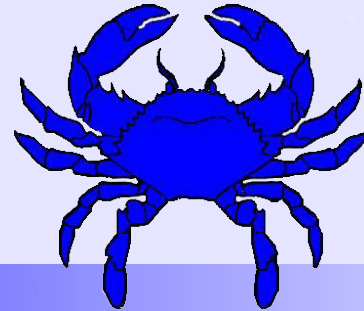


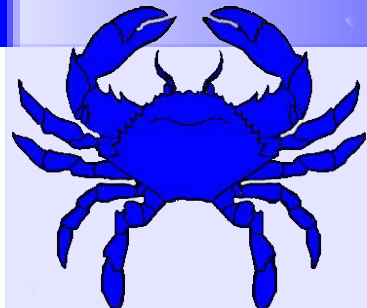
Original recipe from The Good Huswives Jewell by Thomas Dawson c1585:

To farse Eggs
Take eight or ten eggs and boyle them
hard, pill of the
shelles, and cutte every eg in the
middle then take out
the yolkes and make your farsing
stufte as you do for
flesh, saving only you must put butter
into it insteede
of suet, and that a little so doon fill
your Egges where
the yolkes were, and then binde

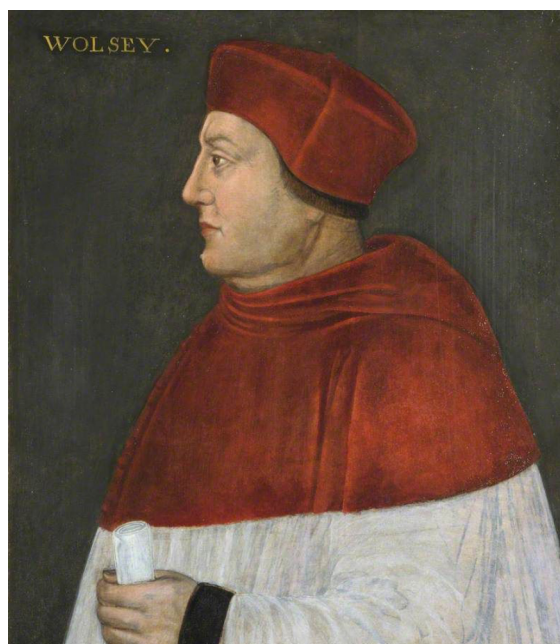

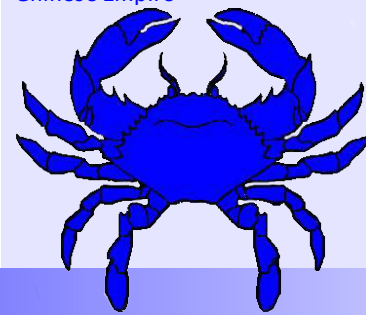

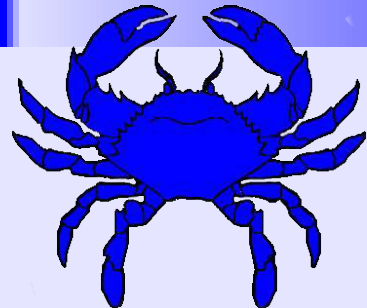

To Farse all things
Take a good handfull of tyme, Isope,
Parselye, and three
or foure yolkes of Egges hard roasted,
and choppe them with
hearbes small, then take white bread
grated and raw eggs
with sweet butter, a few small
Raisons, or Barberies,
seasoning it with Pepper, Cloves,
Mace, Sinamon and Ginger,
working it altogether as paste, and
then may you stuffe
with it what you will.

I decided to try and experiment with
a flavor profile that was more savory
than sweet as listed in the recipe. The
concept being that most people had
gardens more readily available and
trying to think what someone would
walk out and gather with the eggs to
create this dish. The spices and sweeter
version would most likely be served as
part of feasts.

My adaption:

4 eggs, hard boiled and cut in half,
long way
1 Tbsp softened salted butter
2 tsp ground mustard

This created the base in which I played
with a few variations of herb
combinations:

Lovage, Dill, Salt, and a sprinkle of
ground Grains of Paradise
Sage, Chive, and Salt
Garlic, Chive, Salt, and no Grains of
Paradise
Base with Grains of Paradise and
Salt



All yielded an acceptable result. I then
tried it with the original sweeter
variation using cloves, cinnamon,
ginger, and raisins. Again yielded a
perfectly acceptable hard boiled egg but
certainly a much different result.
Depending on the associated dishes in
the remove would determine which
variation to use, savory or sweet.

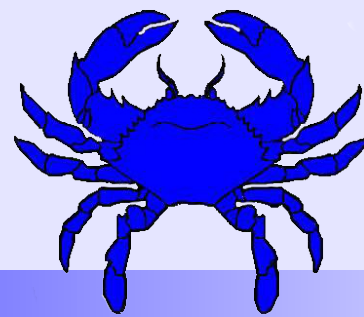

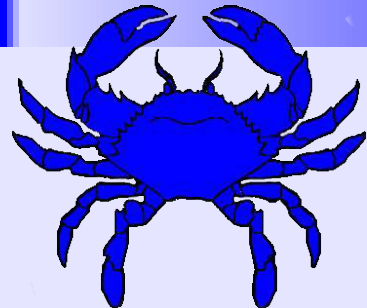
