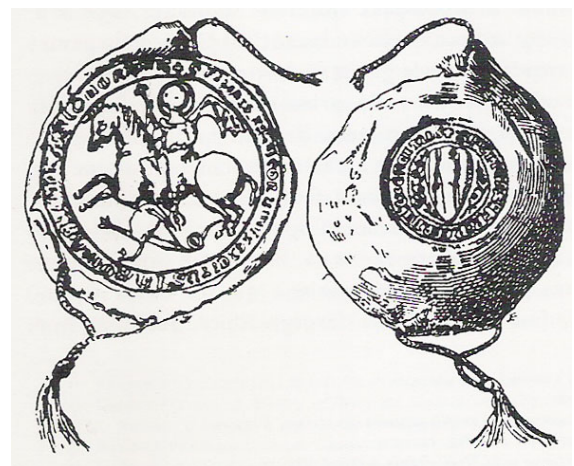
Left: The tetrarchs (from the Greek words for "Four rules") were the four co-rulers that governed the Roman Empire as long as Diocletian's reform lasted. Here they were portrayed embracing, in sign of harmony, in a porphyry sculpture dating from the 4th century, produced in Asia Minor, today on a corner of Saint Mark's in Venice, next to the "Porta della Carta".

The Tetrarchy was the system instituted by Roman Emperor Diocletian on March 1, 293 to govern the ancient Roman Empire by dividing it between two senior emperors, the augusti, and their juniors and designated successors, the caesars. This marked the end of the Crisis of the Third Century.

The title of Supreme Head of the Church of England was created on March 8, 1531 for King Henry VIII when he first began to separate the Church of England from the authority of the Holy See and allegiance to the papacy, then represented by Pope Clement VII.

The Battle of Halmyros, known by earlier scholars as the Battle of the Cephissus or Battle of Orchomenos, was fought on March 15, 1311, between the forces of the Frankish Duchy of Athens and its vassals under Walter of Brienne against the mercenaries of the Catalan Company, resulting in a decisive victory for the mercenaries.

On March 22, 871 The Battle of Merton between the Saxon army of Wessex and the Danish Great Heathen Army took place at an unknown location in Wessex, probably in one of the modern counties of Dorset, Hampshire, or Wiltshire.

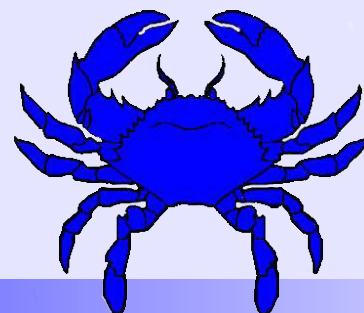

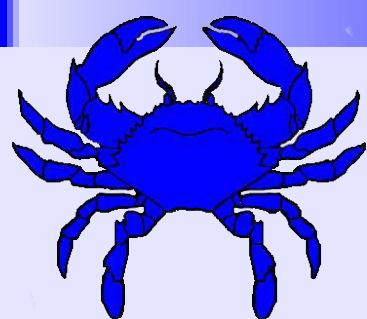

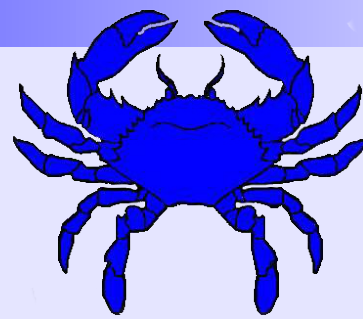
