- ARTICLES IN ADDITION TO REGULAR NEWS, ANYONE WHO WANTS TO CONTRIBUTE ARTICLES TO THE WEBSITE CAN ASK FOR CONTRIBUTOR STATUS. PERFECT FOR SHARING MORE ABOUT A&S RESEARCH YOU'VE DONE.
- Uploads The process for uploading approved files to the website directly has been significantly streamlined.
- INTERACTIVITY ANYONE REGISTERED ON THE FORUMS/SITE CAN MAKE COMMENTS ON NEWS POSTS AND DESIGN HOW THEIR NAME WILL DISPLAY IN THE PROCESS.
- RSS Feed Anyone can subscribe to our News feed and follow us via e-mail or even a mobile phone!

First time users will have to register via the forums. Returning Lochmere users can sign-in once via the forums and then click over to the rest of the site and your information will be transferred over automatically. Officers and Guild/Activity leaders are encouraged to send the Webminister an e-mail letting me know you've done this so I can change your status from Subscriber to Author. Likewise, anyone wishing to be a Contributor should let me know after their first log-in.

I WILL BE PUTTING ARTICLES IN *THE DREDGINGS* EACH MONTH TO SHOW OFF MORE OF OUR NEW FEATURES. I'M ALSO ABOUT HALFWAY DONE WITH A PICTORIAL USER GUIDE FOR THOSE WHO WANT TO LEARN MORE ABOUT THE TECHNOLOGY WITHOUT PLAYING WITH IT TOO MUCH. THIS WILL ALSO INCLUDE A CHAPTER FOR WEBMINISTERS.

EACH MONTH I WILL BE DOING AN ARTICLE IN THE DREDGINGS IN ORDER TO SHOW OFF SOME OF THE FEATURES OF THE WEBSITE WITH THE DESIRED GOAL THAT EVERYONE WILL ENJOY USING IT MORE. THIS MONTH'S FEATURE IS GOING TO FOCUS ON SOME OF THE NEW ASPECTS AND POSSIBILITIES OF THE SITE.

SINGLE SIGN-ON

PREVIOUSLY THE FORUMS AND THE CALENDAR OPERATED ON TWO DIFFERENT SIGN-ONS. I WAS NOT INTERESTED IN MAKING EVERYONE LEARN MULTIPLE SIGN-ONS TO USE THE WEBSITE, SO ONLY I COULD EDIT OUR CALENDAR.

Those days are gone happily. Now just one username gives you access to all site features.

USER LEVELS

AS AN EXTENSION OF OUR SINGLE SIGN-ON, WE HAVE DIFFERENT USER LEVELS TO THE SITE: AUTHORS, CONTRIBUTORS, AND SUBSCRIBERS. ALL USERS WILL START OFF AS SUBSCRIBERS, WHICH GIVES THE ABILITY TO EDIT YOUR PROFILE TO SHOW YOUR SCA NAME BY JUST CLICKING ON 'MY PROFILE' IN THE SIDEBAR. THIS ALSO GIVES YOU THE ABILITY TO POST COMMENTS ON NEWS POSTS.

Anyone who wants to contribute information the website—say an Arts & Sciences article—can ask for Contributor status. Contributors have the ability to create posts but they must be approved beforehand.

OFFICERS, GUILD LEADERS, AND ACTIVITY LEADERS ARE GIVEN AUTHOR STATUS. AUTHORS CAN MAKE NEWS POSTS RIGHT AWAY IN ORDER TO KEEP THE BARONY ADVISED OF IMPORTANT NEWS. AN OFFICER CAN ALSO USE THE SITE FEATURES AS A PLATFORM FOR HIS OR HER OFFICE.

PERSONALITY

One of my major goals for the website besides making it the best possible tool for the Barony is to give the Barony more internet personality. Part of this is achieved by giving officers the opportunity to post information relevant to their office on their category page.

Another part of this is going to be a change to the Officers and Order of Precedence pages.

By now I hope you have noticed that the Officers page includes achievement of arms for each officer. It is my goal to create *Persona Cards* for each person in our OP that will show off not only your awards, but whatever other SCA-relevant information you wish to share: persona period, ethnic origin, biography, SCA biography, etc. We can even include a personal picture on this page.

Again, the goal is to give the Barony a personality on the web so that people have an easier time approaching us.
