Local Event of Interest

The Walters Art Museum Exhibit:

Pearls on a String: Artist, Patrons, and Poets at the Great Islamic Courts

The great Mughal, Safavid, and Ottoman empires flourished during a time of rapid change and artistic innovation in the Islamic world, as people, ideas, and technologies spread across Europe and Asia. At the heart of the empires' courts were networks of individuals—writers, poets, artists, craftsmen—who produced extraordinary works of art for the ruling elite. From November 8, 2015, through January 31, 2016, the Walters Art Museum will present Pearls on a String: Artists, Patrons, and Poets at the Great Islamic Courts, the first major exhibition to focus on these influential and often charismatic individuals.

The free exhibition features more than 120 works including paintings, calligraphy, textiles, ceramics, and jeweled luxury objects. Dating from the 16th to the 18th century, these exquisite works of art were created in historic India, Iran, and Turkey, a vast geographic area that extends from the Bay of Bengal to the Mediterranean Sea.



11th century AH/AD 17th in Iran



 to the barony. The founding

 Traveller, and myself, Lord
 Ilarion Ivanovich Drakonov.
 The event was attended by
 380 people.






On December 17, The Excellencies hosted a bardic circle to celebrate the Yule season. It was well attended and a good time was had by all.

On January 4, a sewing workshop was hosted by **House Idlewild**. It was well attended. Many projects were begun.

At **Ice Castles**, on January 14, the barony of **Lochmere** challenged the barony of **Black Diamond** for their lands. We were victorious. Their lands were returned on the



condition that a treaty be signed stating that **Black Diamond** will provide troops to aid **Lochmere** whenever called for. 

On February 4, in the barony of **Nottingham Coll**, the forces of **Atlantia** met the forces of **Trimaris**. **Atlantia** was victorious. At this event, **Baroness Morgan Argante Alandris** was made **Warlord of Atlantia**. 

At the March business meeting, I announced my intention to resign as the baronial chronicler,
