Lochmere Populace Meeting Notes



Baron and Baroness:

- Pennsic:
 - ♦ Opening ceremonies on Saturday before war-week at 6:00 p.m.
 - ◊ Members of the populous are invited to process in with their Excellencies
 - Sunday evening will be our Baronial Court and Party.—Her Excellency asked for assistance in planning the party
 - ♦ Atlantian Court is Wednesday Evening
- Pavilion Cleaning:
 - His Excellency thanked Christiana and Misha for hosting "Pavilion Cleaning" at their home in Fredcerick
 - His Excellency stated that the Baronial Storage Pavilion was scrubbed, treated with an anti-mildew
 treatment, and rewater-proofed with Starbrite waterproofing treatment-
 - Master Reynard (and others) expressed concern that the method of washing and water-proofing was not in accordance with the advice he provided at the June Barony meeting concerning the proper care of the Sunforger canvas. nor was it consistent with the care instructions provided by the manufacturer

Lochmere Populace Meeting Notes—Continued



- ◊ There is some concern that the structural integrity and waterproofing already manufactured into the canvas has been negatively impacted We'll see what happens at Pennsic
- His Excellency stated that they spent \$130 and asked to be reimbursed—Lady Bryn said that if it was under \$250 we could take an immediate vote—which we did.—the majority voted in favor of reimbursement—nobody opposed, several people abstained

Seneschal:

- Stepping down at Battle on the Bay
- Master Kryss made a last call for additional volunteers willing to take the office-(Anne d'Everaux and Chris-<tiana have taken the Seneschal 101 class)

Chronicler: (not in attendance)

- Mistress Arianna Morgan took the minutes for tonight's meeting (thank you!)
- Newsletter out on time

Exchequer: (emailed report)

- Ledger Balance is \$9,784.25
- We are halfway through the year and would like to report on how we are doing with our annual budget:
 - We have had more income than we have spent by \$407.16—none of the officers/offices have spent any
 of the money approved for their office.
 - ◊ The Seneschal's office has \$50 for general office supplies remaining
 - The Exchequer's office has \$100 for general repair and maintenance of equipment and \$50 for office supplies—As a note we need at least one new cooking pot—Lisette had mentioned that she would buy the pot.
 - The Marshal's office has \$725 set aside for new helms and repair of equipment and \$50 for general supplies—also need a net or back drop for archery practice—Dee and Kryss were going to look into getting the back drop/net—have spent \$1,700 of the \$2,535 set aside for fighter practice.
 - \diamond $\;$ The Herald's office has \$50 for general supplies $\;$
 - \diamond $\;$ The MoAS office has \$50 for general office supplies \;
 - ◊ The Chronicler's office has \$50 for general office supplies
 - ♦ Under General expenses we have \$150 which we thought would be used for paint for the pavilion and

\$400 for 2 instances of Galesville HalL

- ♦ The Pennsic budget I expect will be used with minimum amount remaining
- I would like everyone to start thinking about things we need or want to include in next year's budget and can cemail the item and its cost to exchequer@lochmere.atlantia.sca.org and I will begin to compile a list of items to be voted on for the 2019 budget— deadline for your wish list will be October's business meeting

- There will be an A&S/Newcomer's gathering at Greer's house on July 15th_
 - ◊ Details will be sent out on the list and Facebook

Chatelain:

- Will not be renewing her warrant—any volunteers to fill the office?
- If Gold Key is needed for Pennsic, please let her know ASAP before the Gold Key gets "buried" in the Pennsic Prep!
- Gabe mentioned that a newcomer attended fighter practice last week
