- ♦ At Coronation the Baron was in the Rapier Tournament
  - ♦ Had lots of fun

## Seneschal:

- ♦ Paperwork for Tatiana as Lady Scholastica's replacement as Youth Minister has been signed and submitted
- ♦ Quarterly report is done, just not submitted yet

## Chronicler:

- ♦ Newsletter out on time
- ♦ Thank you to Lady Scholastica Joycors, once again for filling in while I was out

## Exchequer: (emailed report)

- ♦ Ledger Balance is \$9,161.17
- ♦ I have not been able to finalize the event report from NOTT because I don't have all the receipts
  - ♦ It appears that our profit will be around \$1,300 or \$1,400
- ♦ Quarter One report is in progress
- ♦ Reminders for everyone:
  - ♦ I need the contracts or copies of them for my files, including liquor licenses and Site Insurance
    - Many times the only proof to show the cost of a site is the actual contract
    - Because I have to write the check out prior to the contract being in place, I have no receipt for that check until after the event
  - ♦ Going forward I will use a check request form when I write a check without a receipt
- ♦ You can scan or take pictures of your receipts and send them to me
  - ♦ I have to scan them all to send with my quarterly report anyway
  - ♦ You do not have to wait until the event is over to submit your receipts

## Chatelain: (emailed report)

- ♦ This month was a busy one for newcomers!
- ♦ On March 18, we hosted a newcomer's Social that was well attended with seven newcomers and five veteran members of the barony
  - ◊ All went well and there was a lot of well received feedback
- ♦ The following weekend our barony hosted 13 newcomers at Night on the Town, three of those newcomers were outside of our lands and we were able to provide for in conjunction with their local chatelaine
- ♦ On April 21st I attended AwesomeCon and manned the SCA booth spearheaded by the Barony of Storvik
  - ◊ Final report shows that Lochmere has four additional newcomer contacts as a result, contact information pending - as soon as I receive it, I will reach out to those individuals
- ♦ We have been invited to participate in the Crofton STEM Festival on Saturday, April 21 at 11:00 till?
