EXCHEQUER'S TIPS

Event Budgets – why are they so tricky? They are tricky because most autocrats only do them once every few years and forms change. Let's break it down. An event budget has 2 parts - Estimated Income and Estimated Expenses.

Your expenses should never exceed your income, if they do, the budget won't get approved. Don't pad your budget. Don't over estimate attendance and no need to pad your expenses. Your Financial Committee is not Congress, if you ask for \$100 and only spend \$50 and ask for \$125 the next year, we aren't going to deny the \$125 because only \$50 was spent the previous year.

Remember the budget is an estimate, it is soft and has wiggle room. If you exceed your estimate for printing but don't spend everything estimated for General Supplies, you're okay as long as you don't exceed your total estimated expenses. What happens if you exceed your total estimated expenses? It just means the financial committee has to discuss it and approve it before the Exchequer can give you a check for the extra amount. Things happen, just don't let it get out of control.

Try to estimate attendance as best you can for everyone who will attend. Your friendly local exchequer can give you previous years' attendance totals to help you out. Remember your site comps, the autocrat can comp whomever they want but the comps must be in the budget. The Exchequer is happy to help you create your budget, just ask.
