The Battle on the Ice, alternatively known as the Battle of Lake Peipus, took place on April 5, 1242. It was fought largely on

the frozen Lake Peipus between the united forces of the Republic of Novgorod and Vladimir-Suzdal, led by Prince Alexander Nevsky, and the forces of the Livonian Order and Bishopric of Dorpat, led by Bishop Hermann of Dorpat.




