

- Storage: bunch of stuff at Ayanna's, Katla's, Bryns... Aryanna has an inventory that will be shared



If nothing else, you would have gotten darn near perfect weather. The nights were a little chilly but warm fires, hearts, and friends kept our smiles bright. OK... an extra blanket/cloak helped a bit too.

The overriding theme of Battle on the Bay has long been 'all melee, all day' and this year did not disappoint. The flavor of this year's Battle was Games, Puzzles, and Puns. Crafty melee scenarios of all manner challenged many through combat. The A&S was geared toward games. Even the thrown weapons and archery had challenges of the gaming variety. To include a most excellent game of 'thrown weapons Flux' that drew many players. There was also a gaming salon setup for people to step away from the hub-bub and relax with a game of Fox and Geese, or any other dozen or so games that were provided. Even the site tokens were little puzzle pieces. Could we have done a better job of it? Sure. hind sight is always 20/20. That said, I'd be hard pressed to be much happier than I am with the results. 
