

Words from Their Excellencies


Greetings, Lochmere,

B&B: Roxbury, Milled and fair demonstrations went well. Events and practices continue to run on schedule. Please submit award/order recommendations and participate in pollings.

Sen: Unevent will occur on December 2. An accelerated polling of confidence will occur after crown tournament. Make sure your membership is current if you wish to participate. Please sign up to poll on the website to save the Barony money.

Exc: Anne is working on getting Reginald involved as a deputy and finalizing Battle on the Bay financials.

MOAS: We had an excellent showing from artisans at Battle on the Bay. Preparation for A&S at Midwinter's Revel is ongoing, and information should be available soon. A&S space at practice continues to be available. Calligraphy classes may be offered again before moving on to illumination classes. Please reach out with classes you would like to teach and if you would like to have A&S classes on non-practice nights some weeks.

Web: Exchequer information has been updated. Calendar update is in progress.

Chatelain: We had a number of newcomers at Pennsic and Battle on the Bay. A deputy is being sought.

Herald: Nothing to report.

KM: Practice is moving inside this week. If you have waivers that need to be sent to the kingdom waiver deputy, please turn them in at this week's practice. We are looking to schedule another interkingdom fighter practice, tentatively in late October. The office is open for applications.

AR/TW: Report was submitted. Practices are well attended, and the final practice for the year likely will be November 2. The transition to Randvithr as new marshal is ongoing. Thrown weapons targets need replacing, which will be addressed. We need about \$300 for a new archery backstop, to be addressed at a future meeting. We recently had a large donation of equipment to the baronial loaner gear.

Chron: Please submit articles or other content for the Dredgings. Godwin has been warranted and has assisted with creating a newsletter, so the transition is ready pending completion of the formal process. Godwin's accession to the role is approved without opposition by the populace.

MoM: The position is open.
