

## **Lochmere Business Meeting**

4/1/2024

#### Officer Reports

- Baronage: Their Excellencies represented Atlantia at Gulf Wars. Docente Talia was elevated to the Order of the Laurel. At Defending the Gate, Master Jacques and Sir Joselin were elevated to the Order of Defense. This makes Sir Joselin the first person in Atlantia to receive all four bestowed peerages. We need feast servers for Night on the Town; servers feasts will be comped. Please submit award recommendations. If anyone has anything that needs to go to coronation or needs proxies for anything, please let Their Excellencies know.
- Seneschal: The quarterly report has been submitted. The next business meeting will be April 29. A proposal was made to shift meetings to the fourth Monday of the month to prevent issues with newsletter submission deadlines. If the fourth Monday is a holiday, the meeting will occur on the third Monday. This measure was approved unanimously.
- Exchequer: The budget is currently in process. Membership fees and member discount (previously nonmember surcharge) are in effect. Exchequer 301 is now required for anyone who wishes to work gate at events. Reginald will inquire with the Kingdom Exchequer if they will host an online class prior to University.
- MOAS: The quarterly report is due on April 15. Please let Lady Eilionora what A&S projects you have worked on or entered at events since January. Personal projects also count. Open A&S Day was well attended and featured numerous arts. The next one likely will be in June due to the number of upcoming events. Let Lady Eilionora know what classes you would like to teach or what you would like to learn.



#### Officer Reports, Continued

- Webminister: Site maintenance and fixes are ongoing, including trying to fix issues with newsletter uploading.
- Herald: The report is due at the end of the month. Baron Gabrell is aiding Their Excellencies in a project and working with members on submissions.
- Knight Marshal: Practices continue to be held. Ollam Yrsa will be at practice to collect waivers. Ollam Yrsa will be stepping down soon. Please reach out if you wish to be the next Knight Marshal.
- Missile: Practices have been well attended and will continue to happen. Turnover is continuing.
- Chronicler: Lord Godwin submitted the March issue of the Dredgings, featuring as the cover art a scroll painted by Baroness Sarra for Master Melchior's elevation to the Order of the Laurel. The April issue will be published on April 3 and will feature as the cover art an A&S entry by Reginald, photograph taken by Lady Eilionora. Please submit content to Lord Godwin and reach out to him if you would like to become the Baronial Historian.
- Chatelaine: A proposal was made for Lord Bacon to succeed Lady Aine as Chatelaine. The vote will be held at the next meeting. Lord Bacon read into the record his goals for the office, which are reproduced in this issue.
- Youth Chancellor: The position is vacant.

#### Event updates

- Night on the Town: Baroness Marguerite still needs people to help with gate, including a gate coordinator. We need four more servers for feast; their feast cost will be comped. Baroness Marguerite will send Mistress Arianna a list of the equipment she needs so they can coordinate loadout and setup. The rapier schedule will be posted April 2. The event will feature classes, competitions, and a display area. Pre-registration will be via mail only and must be by check. Please let Mistress Arianna know if you will be providing items for Lochmart or if you wish to help.
- On Target: The event flyer has been submitted. We need 1-2 people to assist with spraying the site for poison ivy. Please reach out to Dame Dealla. Logistics are being finalized, and Mistress Arianna is coordinating the chairty bake sale.
- Odenton Library Demo: We are expecting 300 attendees. The event still needs a coordinator for armored combat. Staff meetings will be scheduled in the coming weeks. Please reach out to Lady Marta if you would like to help.
- Battle on the Bay: The site has been reserved for the first weekend in September. Baron Gabrell is the new event steward, and Dame Dealla is marshal in charge. A gate coordinator has been found. Baron Gabrell will post and send an email regarding the staff he still needs. The theme will be songs and sagas, and the event may feature the reinvestiture of Their Excellencies Storvik.
- Midwinter's Revel 2025: Mistress Arianna has secured the site and will deliver the contract and copy of last year's budget notes to Lord Godwin and Lady Arianna. Please reach out to Lord Godwin or Lady Iona if you would like to help with the event.

- Rapier Marshal: The officer responsible for the promotion and practice of fencing within the barony.


