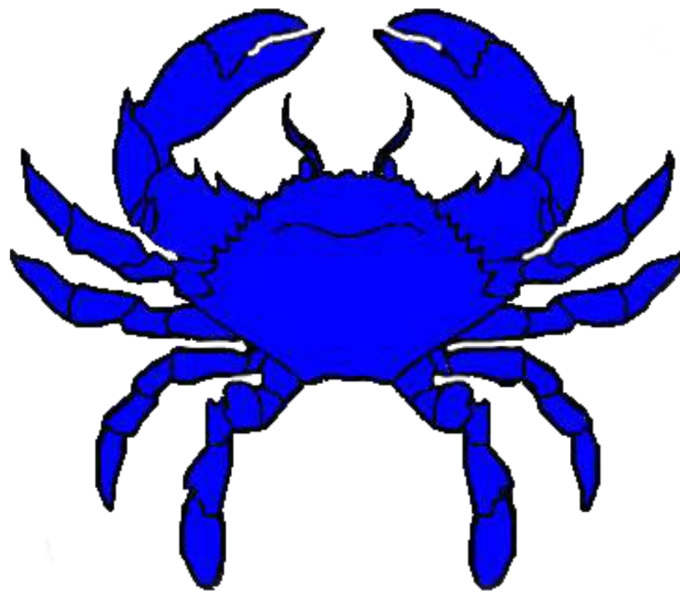

Greetings, Lochmere,

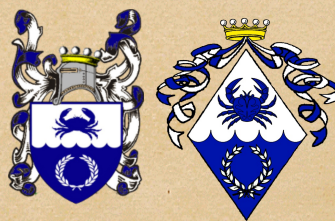

Officer Reports

- Baronage: Their Excellencies attended Defending the Gate, where Dame Dealla and Master Kryss both became Companions of the Order of the Sea Stag. Night at the Faire is on April 12. Their Excellencies' term as baronage will end at Night on the Town 2026. Please start thinking if you would like to succeed to the Lochmere thrones. Their Excellencies also attended Curia.
- Seneschal: Lady Iona attended Curia, where the Kingdom Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Officer was established as an Officer of State. The Deputy Earl Marshal for Training is now an Officer of State.
- Exchequer: The baronial ledger has a balance of \$13,949.13, pending outstanding checks.
- MOAS: Please send Lady Eilionora updates on your projects so she can include them in her report to kingdom. Lady Eilionora's warrant expires in June, so the position is open for application.
- Webminister: Nothing to report.
- Herald: Baron Gabrell continues to work with clients on names and devices. He is seeking a successor, and the position is currently open for applications.
- Knight Marshal: Nothing to report.
- Missile: Practice resumed on March 13th. No equipment or loaner gear appears necessary at this time. Lady Kara submitted her report.



Officer Reports, Continued

- Chronicler: Lord Godwin published the March issue of the Dredgings. Please submit content for the April issue and reach out to Lord Godwin if you would like to donate books to the baronial library. Lord Godwin is also interested in taking on a deputy with an interest in taking over once his warrant ends in July, should he decide to take on another role.
- Chatelaine: Baron Bacon will be attending Night at the Faire. Please reach out if you need loaner gear.
- Youth Chancellor: The position is vacant.

Event updates

- Night on the Town: The site map has been uploaded to the Facebook event page. An email will follow regarding what is needed from baronial storage. Help is needed for setup on Friday and teardown on Saturday. We may have need of a pickup truck to retrieve items from storage. Please let Lady Eilionora know if and when you can help. The site opens at 8:00 for volunteers, and gate opens at 9:00. SCORES registration closes April 6. Help will be needed to set up for feast, as well as voice heralding during the day. The barony has need of garb racks and volunteers for Lochmart, as well as donations for and help with the bake sale. Please submit award recommendations, as well as reservations you may have about being called into court or name corrections or changes.
- On Target: The budget of \$725, with a \$5 charge for feast, is approved unanimously. The event calendar pages have been updated, and SCORES setup is in progress. The A&S competition details have been posted to the website. Targets are in progress. If you have spare materials with which to stuff targets, please contact Lord Randvithr. His Majesty will be attending.
- Pennsic: The barony needs someone to drive the equipment truck. If you would like to camp with the barony, please send an email to Baron Reynaud with a courtesy copy to Mistress Arianna, including in it details regarding tent size and materials. Archery practice will continue during Pennsic.
- Battle on the Bay: SPIKE is pending for the weekend of September 6. The theme is the Four Horsemen. A&S competitions are in the works, as well as marshal activities. A minister of the lists is needed, and we may need archery and thrown weapons marshals.
- Midwinter's Revel 2026: The barony is seeking an event steward.

Other Business

- Equestrian practices with Storvik are beginning in mid-April. Storvik approved funds for insurance at their February meeting.

- **Historian:** A deputy chronicler who assists the baronial chronicler by compiling and publishing the history of the barony.
- **Minister of the Lists:** The officer responsible for organizing and administering martial tournaments and authorizations.
- **Chancellor of Youth Activities:** The officer who organizes activities focused on the youth of the society.
- **Rapier Marshal:** The officer responsible for the promotion and practice of fencing within the barony.
