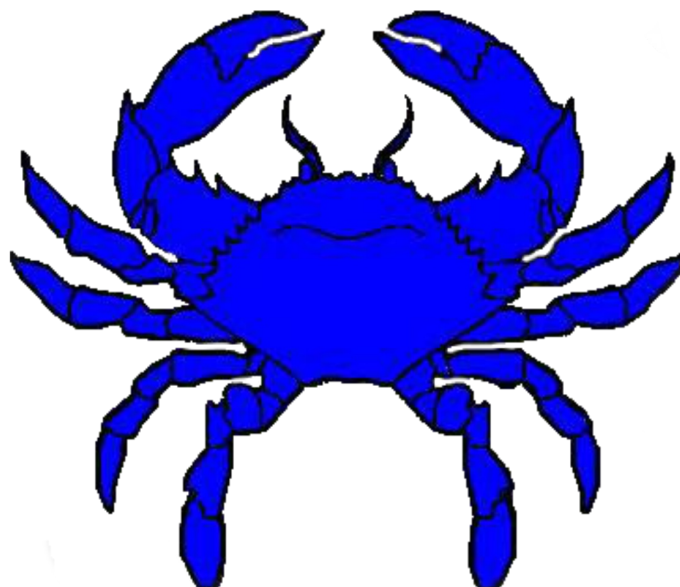

Words from Their Excellencies

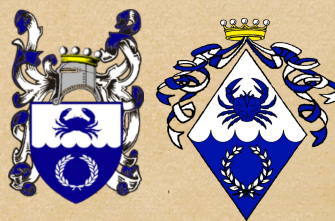
Greetings, Lochmere,

Officer Reports

- Baronage: Their Excellencies are attending Pennsic, where baronial court will be 6:00 P.M. on Tuesday of war week. Her Excellency will negotiate price of the storage unit. Letters of Intent for those interested in becoming the next baronage will be accepted soo. The deadline is twenty weeks prior to Night on the Town.
- Seneschal: Nothing to report.
- Exchequer: The baronial ledger has a balance of \$13,010.57.
- MOAS: The position is vacant.
- Webminister: Not present.
- Herald: Baron Gabrell continues to work with clients on names and devices. He is seeking a successor, and the position is currently open for applications.
- Knight Marshal: Practices continue but will be cancelled during Pennsic. The position is open for applications.
- Missile: Practices continue and will be held during Pennsic. Lord Godwin will run thrown weapons practice during Pennsic, as Dame Dealla and Lord Amleth will be at war. \$75 approved for stocking the snack table at the Pennsic champions' tournament. The position is open for applications.



Officer Reports, Continued

- Chronicler: Lord Godwin published the July issue of the Dredgings and is working to catalogue recent donations to the baronial library. Please submit content for the July issue and reach out to Lord Godwin if you would like to donate books to the baronial library.
- Chatelaine: Baron Bacon is working on newcomer classes and outreach. He will be helping at Newcomer's Point at Pennsic and will drop off supplies for an upcoming demo.
- Youth Chancellor: The position is vacant.

Event updates

- Pennsic: Help is needed for loading the trailer, which will begin Thursday at 9:00 A.M. Brief discussion ensued regarding the coffee club at Pennsic. Attendees are advised to bring a bag of coffee and contact Mistress Arianna.
- Battle on the Bay: Storvik may still need discipline MICs. Dame Dealla will contact the Event MIC.
- Midwinter's Revel: Mistress Arianna and Lady Iona have put together their staff, other than teachers. They have reached out to Lord Klaus about running a coffee house, as this year's tea house was so well received. The event is on the kingdom calendar for January 31. The theme is Way of the Pilgrim.
- Night on the Town: Baroness Cellach and Lord Godwin propose a \$2,900 budget, which is approved, as well as the use of SCORES. Lord Godwin will work to SPIKE the event.
- Library Demos: We have space for a small table at the Bush Library in Annapolis. Lady Eilionora and Lady Katla will host the booth. Baron Bacon will drop off needed supplies.
- On Target: The barony is seeking stewards and staff.

- Rapier Marshal: The officer responsible for the promotion and practice of fencing within the barony.
