Officer Reports

- Baronage: Their Excellencies attended and enjoyed Midwinter's Revel. They are hoping to attend Ymir and Aedult Swim, in addition to Lochmere's Night on the Town and On Target. Their Excellencies presented the first Awards of the Eagle's Eye. The award has not yet passed through the full submission process. The hope is to have an accepted design featuring a iris, feathers, and the colors green and white. Their Excellencies also encouraged members to attend Kingdom University.
- Seneschal: Lady Iona also encouraged attendance at Kingdom University and thanked everyone for attending and helping with Midwinter's Revel.
- Exchequer: The baronial ledger has a balance of \$11,139.04. Reporting should be completed by Thursday.
- MOAS: Lady Eilionora desires to continue monthly A&S hour prior to populace meetings. If you would like to teach or attend classes, please let her know. If you would prefer to have a class other than during fighter practice, please reach out. Lady Eilionora has submitted her quarterly report, and she is seeking feedback from the Midwinter's Revel feast, for which she will develop a form. Please submit A&S projects for the next report.
- Webminister: Lord Farthegn resolved an issue preventing updates from being made to the site infrastructure. He also conducted routine updates, updated the baronial officers page, and posted information about Night on the Town.



Officer Reports, Continued

- Herald: Baron Gabrell continues to work with clients on names and devices. He would like to step down from his office, so applications are now open. Baron Gabrell will remain as a deputy to ensure support and training for his successor.
- Knight Marshal: Nothing to report
- Missile: Practices resume March 13, weather permitting. Dame Dealla is assessing the needs for a baronial arrown-making day.
- Chronicler: Lord Godwin published the January issue of the Dredgings, which featured a cover by Baroness Letia. Please submit content for the upcoming and reach out to Lord Godwin if you would like to donate books to the baronial library. We have received donations from Tim in recent weeks.
- Chatelaine: Not present.
- Youth Chancellor: The position is vacant.

Event updates

- Midwinter's Revel: The event went very well. Lord Godwin and Lady Iona offered thanks to everyone who attended and helped to make their first event as stewards a success. They also specifically thanked the members of their staff, almost all of whom had never served on event staff or in their positions previously. Lady Katla offered an excellent multi-cultural selection of day boards, for which all feedback received has been outstanding, and for which she received an Eagle's Eye. We had three classes, as well as a tea room run by Lord Klaus, which also received significant praise. Three new potential thrown weapons MITs completed the Thrown Weapons 101 class.
- Night on the Town: The event is April 12 at Severn Christian Church. Lady Eilionora presented the budget, which was approved 10-0. The expected breakeven attendance is 112, with 45 for feast. A total of \$2,335 were allocated for event expenditures. The event has been added to the kingdom calendar. 68 spots are available for feast. Two competitions are set: high gothic illumination and items for a traveling craftsman. Reach out to Lady Eilionora or Lady Ava if you would like to teach a late-period German class. Lord Farthegn is rapier marshal in charge and has two competitions in the works. Lady Kara is archery marshal in charge, and Master Kryss is thrown weapons marshal in charge. We still need an event marshal in charge, minister of the lists, hall steward, and field steward. Dame Caitriona is head cook. There is potential for day shades. Please reach out to Lady Eilionora if you are interested in merchanting at the event. Lord Reginald will lead gate staff. Help with setup and tear-down will be needed.
- On Target: Site has been confirmed for May 31, and the event has been SPIKEd. An A&S challenge is being planned.
- Pennsic: Information should be coming in future months. If you are interested in driving the baronial truck in future years, please reach out.
- Battle on the Bay: No updates.
- Midwinter's Revel 2026: The barony is seeking an event steward.
