



Officer Reports

- Baronage: Baronial letters of intent are due December 20 and should be sent to the regional seneschal and Lady Iona. There will be a special baronial meeting on January 19 for a meet-and-greet with the baronage candidates. Check ESP and update your preferences for awards, courts, and titles, as there are numerous new options, including a list of events you plan to attend. Please submit award recommendations and record your continuing education classes from Unevent. Their Highnesses will be attending Midwinter's Revel. There will be a gift exchange at the event. Her Majesty wanted to address some confusion stemming from a miscommunication, intending only to begin a conversation about changes to polling/nonpolling orders; there are currently no planned changes.
- Seneschal: Lady Iona attended Unevent. Barionial polling will be coming soon.
- Exchequer: The baronial ledger has a balance of \$12,862. Timelines for deposits will be changing. New, complex draft of quarterly reports is open for comment. Check for the Battle on the Bay site fee has been sent.
- MOAS: The position is vacant.
- Webminister: Not present.
- Herald: Not present. Baron Gabrell is seeking a successor, and the position is currently open for applications.
- Knight Marshal: The position is open for applications. Lord Randvithr submitted his report.
- Missile: Practices have been completed for the year.



Officer Reports, Continued

- Chronicler: Lord Godwin published the December issue of the Dredgings and will endeavor to have the baronial library at upcoming meetings and events. Please reach out to him if you would like to peruse the library or donate it to it. Per baronial policy, officers should be submitting their reports to both the seneschal and chronicler prior to the business meeting.
- Chatelaine: Nothing to report.
- Youth Chancellor: The position is vacant.

Event updates

- Midwinter's Revel: Help is needed to pick up banners and poles the night before the event, as well as for setting up on the day of the event. Pilgrim passports and a scavenger hunt are planned. A&S will begin at the starting time of the event. Day boards will be served at 11:00, 3:00, and 6:00. Court will be at 5:00. The class schedule is in progress. There will be a night of decoration finishing at Mistress Arianna's house on January 9; please reach out via email or text message if you would like to help. On the day of the event, the small conference room will serve as the royal ready room, as the site library was unavailable.
- Night on the Town: Baroness Cellach and Lord Godwin are beginning to plan decorations and are still seeking volunteers for marshal in charge, target archery marshal in charge, and A&S coordinator.
- On Target: The budget is in progress, with the vote to occur at the upcoming special meeting. The expected expenditures are \$633. Expected attendance is 40-50 people. There will be no change from last year's gate fee, but there will be a \$5 fee for feast.
- Battle on the Bay: The site has been secured. This will be Storvik's investiture.

Open Officer Positions

- Herald: The officer who serves as the voice of the baronage at events and aids members with heraldic submissions.
- Minister of Arts and Sciences: The officer responsible for promoting the arts and sciences within the barony, including coordinating classes and competitions.
- Historian: A deputy chronicler who assists the baronial chronicler by compiling and publishing the history of the barony.
- Minister of the Lists: The officer responsible for organizing and administering martial tournaments and authorizations.
- Chancellor of Youth Activities: The officer who organizes activities focused on the youth of the society.
- Rapier Marshal: The officer responsible for the promotion and practice of fencing within the barony.
- Thrown Weapons Marshal: The officer responsible for the promotion and practice of thrown weapons within the barony.

Upcoming Vacancies

- Seneschal: The barony's legal representative. Ensures compliance with mundane, society, and kingdom law and administers baronial business.
- Chronicler. The baronial secretary. Publishes the baronial newsletter, maintains the baronial library, and publishes baronial history.
- Knight Marshal: The officer responsible who oversees all martial events and practices in the barony. The knight marshal also supervises the barony's discipline marshals.
- Archery Marshal: The officer responsible for the promotion and practice of target archery within the barony.
