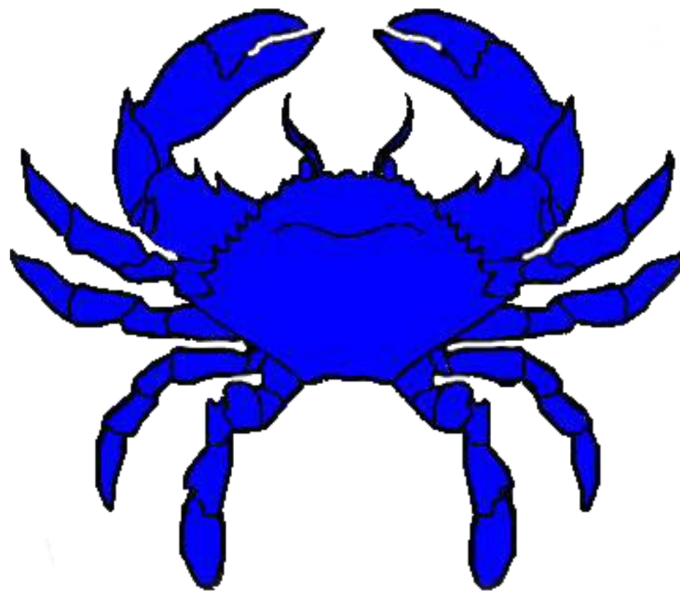

## Lochmere Business Meeting

6/24/2024

### Officer Reports

- Baronage: Their Excellencies thank everyone who helped with the library demo, particularly Lady Marta, who coordinated the event. Dun Carraig is hosting a Pennsic-preparation event on July 13, which will feature authorizations. The guide for camping with the barony has been posted to the baronial website; a poll regarding the timing of baronial court at Pennsic will be published soon. This year's Pennsic Guide has been published. Volunteers are needed for Pennsic Children's Fete. Please submit award recommendations and complete the survey regarding preferences for receiving awards, titles, desired scribes/illuminators, and whom you would like notified when you will be receiving awards. The storage location that holds the baronial gear is raising prices soon, but the rate can be locked in by prepaying, and the increase would be within the amount already budgeted. \*Motion to approve prepayment for six months at current rate is approved unanimously.
- Seneschal: Anne Arundel County is changing the libraries' hours of operation; all branches will now close at 8:00. Because of this, meetings will begin at 7:00 going forward. There will be no July meeting due to Pennsic; the next meeting will be on August 26.
- Exchequer: The baronial account has a balance of \$11,551. Lord Reginald is still awaiting check-writing approval.
- MOAS: The Deputy MOAS, Lady Ava, held a spoon-carving class last week. There will be an A&S Day next Monday, July 1, at the Busch Library in Annapolis, from 6:00-8:00. There will be space to lay out fabric and other projects. Lady Eilionora is willing to host her Intro to Scrollwork that day. Please send her your A&S updates.





## Officer Reports, Continued

- Webminister: Lord Fartheign updated the website to the latest version of Wordpress and updated formatting to improve mobile compatibility.
- Herald: Baron Gabrell submitted Lady Iona's name for registration. He continues to work on registration of names and badges for baronial awards.
- Knight Marshal: The vote to approve Lord Randvithr as the new knight marshal, pending his receipt of his knight-marshal warrant, passes unanimously. Practices are continuing. If heat becomes an issue, practice may be able to move inside, pending approval from the practice site. Contact Baron Gabrell with feedback regarding this proposition. There will not be practice on June 25 and July 2.
- Missile: Practices are continuing. Lord Randvithr is now the target archery marshal for Highland Havoc. Lord Godwin and Lady Iona have received their training warrants for target archery and thrown weapons.
- Chronicler: Lord Godwin published the June edition of the Dredgings, featuring a cover photo by Lady Iona of Master Kryss' excellent spear throw from Ruby Joust. The newsletter also featured Lady Kara's recap of and trivia from On Target. He will publish the July edition by July 5. Please submit content.
- Chatelaine: Lord Bacon's warrant has been approved. The library demo went well, with 200-300 people attending. Lord Bacon has established contact with four attendees from the demo.
- Youth Chancellor: The position is vacant.

## Event updates

- Odenton Library Demo: The demo went very well, and the library would like to continue the partnership. Lady Marta volunteered to coordinate it again and will attempt to obtain a fall date.
- Pennsic: Lochmere again is hosting the Known World Thrown Weapons Championship, run by Dame Dealla and Master Kryss. A request for \$75 for food and tableware for the event passes unanimously. We will need help with the loadout; a Facebook event will be created.
- Battle on the Bay: The budget passes unanimously. The event cost will be \$15 for members, \$25 for nonmembers, and \$5 for camping. We are expecting approximately 225 people. Lochmere is hosting, but the event will feature the reinvestiture of Their Excellencies John and Gracia of Storvik. Please reach out to Baron Gabrell if you would be willing to serve as feast steward, minister of the list in charge, or a discipline marshal. The A&S competition will be performing arts (sagas and songs), and Lady Eilionora would like a deputy to coordinate the performing-arts classes and competition.
- Midwinter's Revel 2025: Lady Katla is working with her peer to develop a menu; the budget will follow, which will then permit the contract to be completed. Please contact Lord Godwin or Lady Iona if you would be willing to serve as reservationist, A&S coordinator, or hall steward.
- Night on the Town 2025: Planning is beginning.
- On Target 2025: Dates are being discussed for next year.
- Battle on the Bay 2025: Lady Iona volunteers as deputy event steward and 2026 event steward.

Next meeting: August 26, 7:00 at the Odenton library.
