

Officer Reports

- Baronage: Their Excellencies attended Ymir. They will be attending Night at the Faire but will not be attending Kingdom Arts and Sciences Festival.
- Seneschal: Curia is March 9th. Lady Iona will attend remotely.
- Exchequer: The baronial ledger has a balance of \$13,309.14, including a \$405 profit from Midwinter's Revel. Exchequer 301 remains required to work troll at events. Raghnailt is working on obtaining her warrant as deputy.
- MOAS: Please send Lady Eilionora updates on your projects so she can include them in her report to kingdom.
- Webminister: Lord Farthegn updated the Wordpress version for the baronial website and is working on bug prevention across baronial infrastructure. He must manually convert pages to the new system, but all changes to the homepage and Night on the Town pages have been made.
- Herald: Baron Gabrell continues to work with clients on names and devices. He is seeking a successor, and the position is currently open for applications.
- Knight Marshal: Practices continue. A vote to sell excess loaner gear at Lochmart passes 12-0.
- Missile: Practice resumes on March 13th. Dame Dealla is organizing arrows and other supplies to determine what is needed for a work day. The barony should not need new target backing this year.



Officer Reports, Continued

- Chronicler: Lord Godwin published the February issue of the Dredgings. Please submit content for the March issue and reach out to Lord Godwin if you would like to donate books to the baronial library.
- Chatelaine: Baron Bacon is working on demos and developing a demo handbook.
- Youth Chancellor: The position is vacant.

Event updates

- Night on the Town: The MOLIC position has been filled, but other MOLs will still be needed. Royal rounds will be held for archery. Budget is introduced: breakeven point of 112 attendees and 45 feasts. There will be 68 feast slots. \$2,285 allocated for event, with budget passing unanimously. We will need site tokens, as well as field and hall stewards, and help with setup and teardown. A crossbow-making class may be held. Two A&S competitions are planned. Lord Reginald will lead gate. Discipline marshals have been found, but an event MIC is needed.
- On Target: Site has been confirmed for May 31. More gate volunteers will be needed. Baron Bacon volunteers to assist Master Reynard with the pig roast. Budget is in progress and may include a \$5 fee for the pig. There will be an A&S challenge.
- Pennsic: The barony needs someone to drive the equipment truck.
- Battle on the Bay: Storvik is hosting this year. The event will be held from September 4th to 6th and should be SPIKEd soon. The theme is the Four Horsemen.

- Rapier Marshal: The officer responsible for the promotion and practice of fencing within the barony.
