

Officer Reports

- Baronage: If you would like to provide gifts for the royals, please let Their Excellencies know, so they can take the gifts to Crown Tournament. His Excellency will be attending Highland Havoc. Their Excellencies will be attending fighter and missile practice this week.
- Seneschal: County libraries are now closing at 8, so meetings will begin at 7. We will need to begin in-depth discussions about potential library demos.
- Exchequer: The baronial account currently has \$12,399.04. One of the attendees at Battle on the Bay had their check flagged as fraudulent; Lord Reginald is working to address the issue. Lord Reginald will complete his quarterly report in the next week. Lord Reginald is seeking a deputy, as he may soon be required to travel significantly for work.
- MOAS: Lady Eilionora submitted her quarterly report. The regional MOAS expressed appreciation for the high level of participation in the barony. Monthly A&S hours prior to business meetings will continue. Lady Eilionora is hoping to set up another A&S day at one of the libraries and will be available to help transport gifts to Crown Tournament.
- Webminister: Lord Fartheign has addressed issues with the website security software and conducted a series of website updates.



Officer Reports, Continued

- Herald: Baron Gabrell continues to help clients with submissions. Lord Godwin's name has been registered.
- Knight Marshal: Practices continue. Nothing new to report.
- Missile: The final regular practice of the year is October 31 and will feature pumpkin targets. Lord Randvithr and Lady Kara are working to reserve the On Target site for a practice in November, which will include royal rounds. The day also potentially will feature A&S and fighting. Dame Dealla offers thanks to Lady Litta for the donation of wood for new thrown weapons targets and to His Excellency for cutting them.
- Chronicler: Lord Godwin submitted the October of the Dredgings, featuring as the cover a Golden Dolphin scroll painted by Her Excellency. The October issue will be published by October 5.
- Chatelaine: Lord Bacon went to War of the Wings and aided with Newcomer Point. He will submit his report.
- Youth Chancellor: The position is vacant.

Event updates

- Midwinter's Revel: The event has been spiked and recorded on the kingdom calendar. SCORES application recently became outdated, so that submission needs to be updated. Lady Katla has released her tentative menu for the rotating day boards. Classes are being finalized. A&S will feature a display of new-to-artisan projects, a cocktail competition, and a lunar-themed competition. If you would like to donate items for the prize baskets, please contact Lord Godwin or Lady Iona. Please also reach out if you would like to participate in a garb-making day prior to the event, so you can have region-appropriate garb for the event.
- Night on the Town: The event will tentatively be on April 12th at Severn Christian Church. Lady Eilionora is finalizing the budget, hopefully to be presented at the next meeting. The theme is a late-period German fair. A feast steward has been tentatively found, but we will still need a marshal-in-charge, a field coordinator, and missile marshals. Lochmart will be present. Lady Ava has tentatively agreed to run A&S; please let Lady Eilionora know if you would like to teach, sponsor a competition, or be deputy event steward.
- On Target: The event tentatively will be on May 31st and feature an astrology theme. Lord Randvithr will contact Master Reynaud to determine if he will be serving the traditional pig roast.
