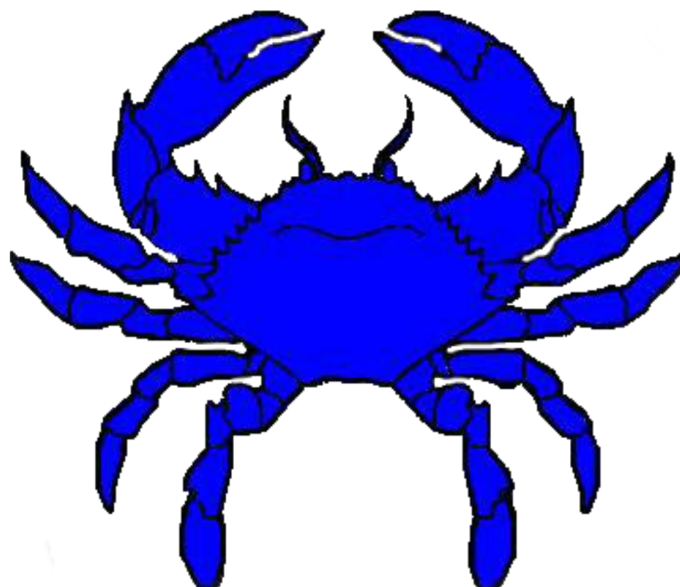

Greetings, Lochmere,

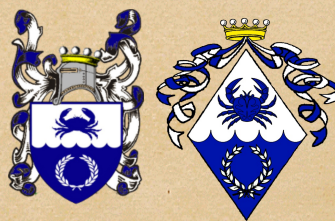

Officer Reports

- Baronage: Officer emails are working. If you have not activated your account, talk to Her Excellency for information. There will not be forwarding with the emails, per kingdom. Regarding the storage unit, rent is now \$85 per month, the top of the allotted budget. Her Excellency will call the corporate office to see if there is a reduced rate for nonprofits. It may be worth price checking and taking a full inventory of supplies. Their Excellencies will attend Festival of Bones but not Holiday Faire. Letters of intent for baronage are due December 20. Start talking up your interests, if you would like to put your name forward. Their Excellencies are considering hosting a question-and-answer session for those interested. Please submit award recommendations.
- Seneschal: Lady Iona now has access to the seneschal email. Nothing else to report.
- Exchequer: The baronial ledger has a balance of \$13,047.57.
- MOAS: The position is vacant.
- Webminister: Lord Farthegn has been working on website updates. He has sent an email to kingdom because of security vulnerabilities in the web infrastructure. He is in the process of updating the "vacant offices" page and moving the baronial event calendar to baronial infrastructure.
- Herald: Baron Gabrell continues to work with clients on names and devices. He is seeking a successor, and the position is currently open for applications.
- Knight Marshal: Practices continue, now inside. The position is open for applications.



Officer Reports, Continued

- Missile: Practices continue, with the last being a Halloween shoot on October 30. Dame Dealla has scheduled a Target Archery Marshal 101 class for November 16. Please contact her if you are interested. The office is open for applications.
- Chronicler: Lord Godwin published the October issue of the Dredgings. Please submit content for the November issue and reach out to Lord Godwin if you would like to donate books to the baronial library. Lord Godwin will make the baronial library available at meetings and may be able to have it at practices or events. The position is open for applications.
- Chatelaine: Baron Bacon received an email from a potential newcomer and returned it but has not heard back.
- Youth Chancellor: The position is vacant.

Event updates

- Midwinter's Revel: Mistress Arianna submitted the SCORES application and will coordinate publicity beginning next week. Lady Katla's menu has been prepared. Information for the website will be sent, and event scheduling will begin soon. Pilgrim passports will be updated for the event, and completing a passport will earn attendees a prize.
- Night on the Town: Baroness Cellach and Lord Godwin are still in need of an event marshal-in-charge, target archery marshal-in-charge, and A&S coordinator. Sir Hugh is working on the menu and will prepare an allergy matrix.
- On Target: Dame Dealla and Noble Ragnailt are preparing the budget and site contract.
- Pennsic: Preparation should begin in the coming months. Email baronreynard@gmail.com if you would like to camp with the barony.
- Battle on the Bay: Two dates in October are available for Croom: the weekend of Halloween and the weekend prior to it. A motion to approve emergency funding to secure the site for the weekend prior to Halloween is approved. Dame Emma and Baroness Carrie Ann have offered to step up once Lady Iona departs Atlantia.

Open Officer Positions

- Herald: The officer who serves as the voice of the baronage at events and aids members with heraldic submissions.
- Minister of Arts and Sciences: The officer responsible for promoting the arts and sciences within the barony, including coordinating classes and competitions.
- Historian: A deputy chronicler who assists the baronial chronicler by compiling and publishing the history of the barony.
- Minister of the Lists: The officer responsible for organizing and administering martial tournaments and authorizations.
- Chancellor of Youth Activities: The officer who organizes activities focused on the youth of the society.
- Rapier Marshal: The officer responsible for the promotion and practice of fencing within the barony.
- Thrown Weapons Marshal: The officer responsible for the promotion and practice of thrown weapons within the barony.

Upcoming Vacancies

- Seneschal: The legal representative of the barony, oversees compliance with mundane and SCA laws and ensures smooth operations of the barony.
- Chronicler: The baronial secretary, produces the monthly Dredgings newsletter and maintains the baronial library. Also serves as the baronial historian, if no separate historian exists.
- Knight Marshal: The officer responsible who oversees all martial events and practices in the barony. The knight marshal also supervises the barony's discipline marshals.
