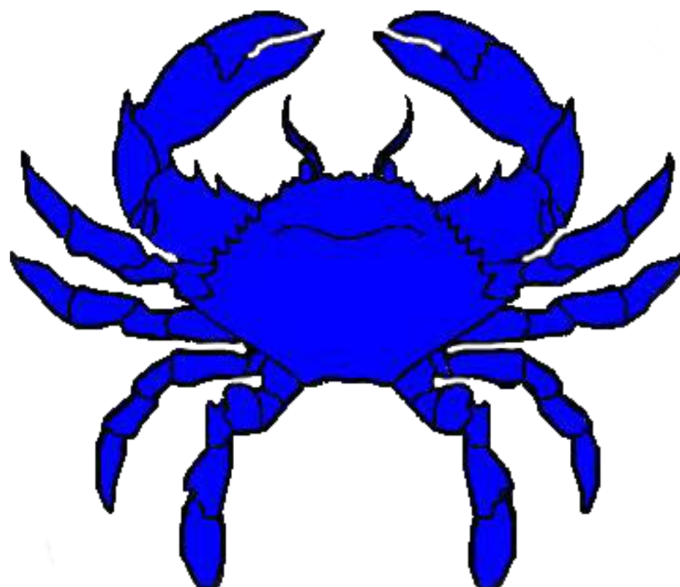

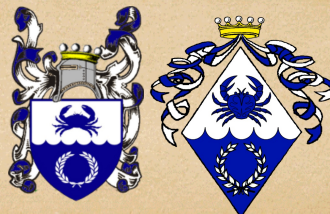

Lochmere Business Meeting

Officer Reports

- Baronage: Their Excellencies offered a tribute to the late Baroness Gracie of Storvik. There will be a celebration of life for her at War of the Wings, as well as a local funeral. Lord Leon is coordinating care packages for Baron John, while Mistress Tirzah is coordinating food for the local funeral. Letters of intent for those wishing to become the next baronage are due December 20.
- Seneschal: Lady Iona was deputy event steward for Battle on the Bay, which went well.
- Exchequer: The baronial account currently has a balance of \$13,047.57. Lord Reginald will coordinate checks for practice and site rental with Baron Gabrell.
- MOAS: The position is vacant.
- Webminister: Lord Farthegn has fixed issues with the baronial website and updated the officer page.
- Herald: Baron Gabrell continues to work with clients on names and devices. He is seeking a successor, and the position is currently open for applications.
- Knight Marshal: Practices continue and will be moving inside next week. The position is open for applications.
- Missile: The last practice of the year will be on October 30, which will be a Halloween shoot. Lord Godwin will run thrown weapons at practice this week, as Dame Dealla will be celebrating a religious holiday. The position is open for applications.



Officer Reports, Continued

- Chronicler: Lord Godwin published the September issue of the Dredgings. The baronial library has had its first two patrons: Noble Ragnailt and Lord Scott. Lord Godwin is seeking a successor to take over around March or April, as he and Lady Iona may be moving out of kingdom around that time.
- Chatelaine: Not present
- Youth Chancellor: The position is vacant.

Event updates

- Battle on the Bay: The event went well and featured horses, arts and sciences, and an attendance of over 300 people. Lord Godwin stepped up as a last-minute MOL/IC, due to glitches with the warrant system preventing the initial MOL/IC from serving.
- Midwinter's Revel: Information for arts and sciences has been added to the event announcement, and classes will be added soon. Mistress Arianna and lady Iona are working on finalizing classes, for which they have 3-4 commitments, including dancing and a Turkish coffee house. Decoration-making day will be on October 25. Lady Katla is testing recipes. mistress Arianna has requested permission to edit the event page on the baronial website.
- Night on the Town: The event still needs an arts and sciences coordinator, event marshal-in-charge, and target archery marshal-in-charge. Lord Godwin will follow up regarding staff. The menu is in progress.
- On Target: Noble Ragnailt will be steward, and Dame Dealla will be marshal-in-charge.
- Battle on the Bay 2026: Lady Iona will need a successor steward if her mundane move is completed. The current plan is to have nearly everything already in order, so the new steward will need only to complete the final preparations and oversee the event itself and after-action duties.

Open Officer Positions

- Herald: The officer who serves as the voice of the baronage at events and aids members with heraldic submissions.
- Minister of Arts and Sciences: The officer responsible for promoting the arts and sciences within the barony, including coordinating classes and competitions.
- Historian: A deputy chronicler who assists the baronial chronicler by compiling and publishing the history of the barony.
- Minister of the Lists: The officer responsible for organizing and administering martial tournaments and authorizations.
- Chancellor of Youth Activities: The officer who organizes activities focused on the youth of the society.
- Rapier Marshal: The officer responsible for the promotion and practice of fencing within the barony.
- Thrown Weapons Marshal: The officer responsible for the promotion and practice of thrown weapons within the barony.

Upcoming Vacancies

- Seneschal: The legal representative of the barony, oversees compliance with mundane and SCA laws and ensures smooth operations of the barony.
- Chronicler: The baronial secretary, produces the monthly Dredgings newsletter and maintains the baronial library. Also serves as the baronial historian, if no separate historian exists.
- Knight Marshal: The officer responsible who oversees all martial events and practices in the barony. The knight marshal also supervises the barony's discipline marshals.
- Archery Marshal: The officer responsible for the promotion and practice of target archery within the barony.
