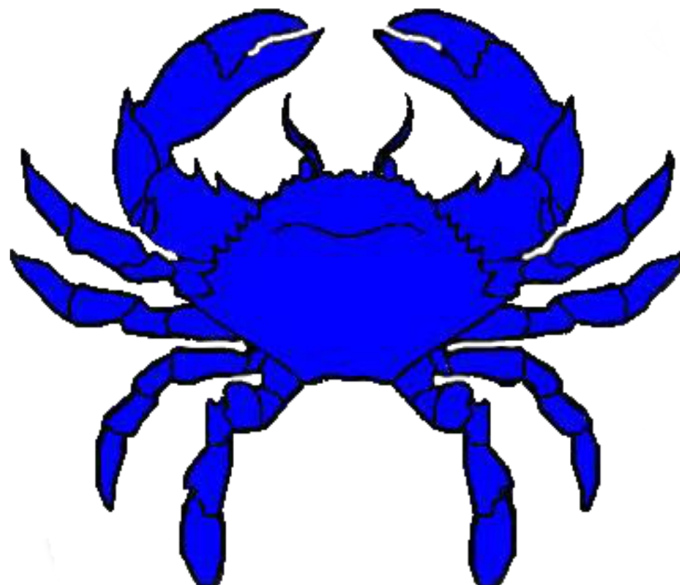

Words from Their Excellencies

Greetings, Lochmere,

Pennsic! We went to war and camped with the Barony. It was a soggy Pennsic for those who spent the full two weeks on site. We only were able to attend a single week this year, so we missed most of the rain except for an intense storm that included hail and a beautiful double rainbow over camp.

We were able to hold a soggier-than-expected court after the rain, where we honored Master Kryss with a Sable Squirrel and Gilles and Aeldra with Crab's Hammers. Their Majesties allowed us to be Their representatives and present Shark's Teeth to Master Kryss and Liam and induct Liam into the Order of the Hippocampus. After court, we also hosted an apprentice ceremony for Noble Bronwyn to Magistra Sigrid.

We were able to witness the Knowne World Baronial Thrown Weapons Champions' Tournament, as well as the Thrown Weapons Champions' War Point. We must say, Lochmere looks great on those fields!

We shot some points for populace archery, and His Excellency made a special outfit in order to be able to compete in the period shoot. Shortly afterward, Lord Amleth represented Us in the Knowne World Baronial Archery Champions' Tournament.

Officer Reports

- Baronage: Pennsic was excellent, despite the weather. Many thanks are offered to all who helped when the truck malfunctioned. Master Kryss received a Sable Squirrel and performed well in the thrown weapons competition. Liam received a Shark's Tooth and a Hippocampus for his efforts in the youth thrown weapons tournament. Gilles and Aeldra received Crab's Hammers. The demo in Bright Hills went well, and there is potential for new recruits for practice and Battle on the Bay. Their Excellencies offered the baronial day shade for Trial by Fire, even if they are unable to attend.
- Seneschal: County libraries are now closing at 8, so meetings will begin at 7. The Severn library wants a small demo next fall. This likely would be A&S focused, given the location restrictions.
- Exchequer: The baronial account currently has \$10,839.70. There is a \$50 discrepancy between the checkbook and account, likely an error in initial accounting that has carried forward. Lord Reginald has elevated this to kingdom. Lord Reginald has received signatory authority on the baronial accounts and submitted his report.
- MOAS: We had an A&S get-together prior to Pennsic, focusing on scribal arts. Lady Eilionora hopes to schedule another open A&S day after Battle on the Bay. Please send Lady Eilionora your A&S content for her report and fill out the kingdom's Google form if you participated in A&S activities at Pennsic. There were four attendees at this month's pre-meeting A&S hour.
- Webminister: Not present.



Officer Reports, Continued

- Herald: Baron Gabrell helped a client redesign their arms and submitted his report.
- Knight Marshal: Practices are continuing, and we have welcomed a handful of new attendees. We may need new loaner gear.
- Missile: Practices are continuing and have featured excellent turnout, particularly on the youth side. A tentative Halloween shoot is being planned. The baronial tournaments at Pennsic went well. The new peerage name, device, and regalia suggestions have been unveiled.
- Chronicler: Lord Godwin submitted the July and August issues of the Dredgings, featuring as the cover arts a photo by Lady Kara of the floating On Target target and a photo by His Excellency of the Pennsic baronial champions archery competition, respectively. The September issue will be published on September 5.
- Chatelaine: Not present.
- Youth Chancellor: The position is vacant.

Event updates

- Battle on the Bay: A volunteer is needed to transport the 20'x30' baronial pavilion; Lord Randvithr volunteers. Storvik is providing the list fence. Lady Eilionora is looking for a small popup to host the bardic events; Lady Marta offers hers. Heavy and rapier fighting will feature numerous melee scenarios, and archery and thrown weapons will be present. There also will be a feast, dancing, bardic, and equestrian events in addition to. Lochmere will be hosting a popup day board. Volunteers to help with coordinating performing arts are needed. There will be a fundraiser to benefit the hound coursers.
- Midwinter's Revel: The budget has been submitted. A vote to approve the budget passes 11-0 after assurances that it can be amended if needed, particularly if the response to the rolling day boards is greater than expected. Lady Katla will be finalizing the menu in the coming weeks. A potential A&S coordinator has been found; Lord Godwin and Lady Iona will converse more with them. Three classes are in the works, and one to two more would be appreciated. Lord Randvithr inquires if the facility will have space for a nap room for children. A bag game coordinator is still needed.
- Night on the Town: The event is still in initial planning stages.
- On Target: No updates at this time.

Other Business

- Pennsic went well, other than the truck issues. Several people camped with the barony for the first time.
