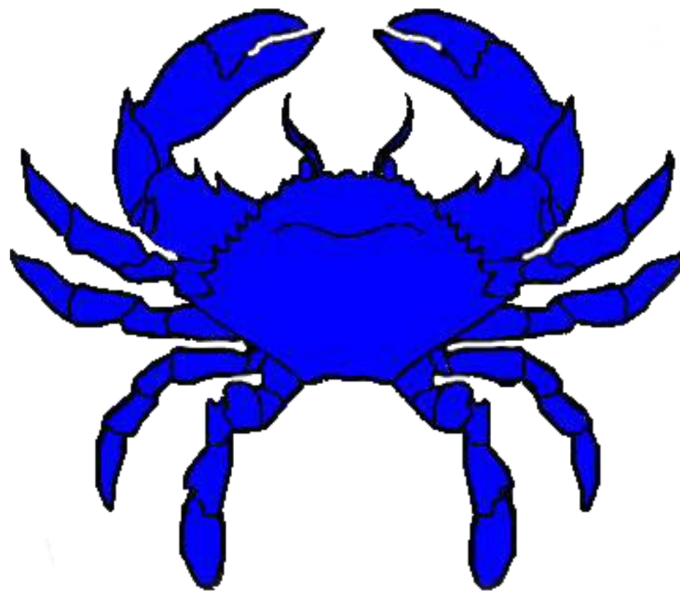

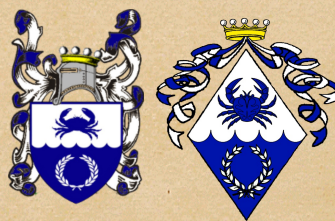
Words from Their Excellencies

Officer Reports

- Baronage: Their Excellencies attended Pennsic and held a baronial court, at which a Baronial Award of Excellence, Sable Squirrels, and a Crab and U-Haul were presented. Battle on the Bay is next on the schedule. Please send award recommendations. Their Excellencies are unable to attend Trial by Fire but will be attending coronation, Festival of Bones, crown tournament, and potentially Hallowed Market and War of the Wings. Curia is September 14. Letters of intent for the baronial polling are due December 20, with submissions being accepted beginning around November 22.
- Seneschal: Lady Iona is deputy steward for Battle on the Bay. More discussion is upcoming during the events section.
- Exchequer: The baronial ledger has a balance of \$13,110.57, which is a slight discrepancy with the most recent statement. Lord Reginald is working with the regional exchequer to fix the error. Lord Reginald has submitted his report. He may be taking a work assignment in the coming months that would transfer him out of the barony, so he is preparing Noble Raghnaill to take over, if necessary. Lord Reginald will give the checks for Night on the Town to Baron Gabrell.
- MOAS: The position is vacant.
- Webminister: Not present.
- Herald: The position is currently open for applications.
- Knight Marshal: Not present. The position is open for applications.



Officer Reports, Continued

- Missile: Practices continue and are well attended. Lord Godwin's target archery warrant was approved. The position is open for applications.
- Chronicler: Lord Godwin published the August issue of the Dredgings. Please submit content for the September issue and reach out to Lord Godwin if you would like to donate books to the baronial library. Lord Godwin is continuing to catalogue recent donations.
- Chatelaine: Baron Bacon established contact with newcomers at Pennsic. He will attend Battle on the Bay
- Youth Chancellor: The position is vacant.

Event updates

- Pennsic: The baronial camp was nice and provided lessons in proper spacing. Mistress Arianna thanks the camp helpers. Minions were needed this year and will be needed in the future. Only one of the five people at land grab was under 60.
- Battle on the Bay: Storvik is hosting this year. The event will be held from September 4th to 6th at Croom Park. Lady Iona is the deputy. Help is needed with gate, particularly for Saturday at opening. Lochmere will have a baronial pavilion for Lochmart, which will be set up some time on Friday. Sir Helmut is event MIC, with Master Fearghus as thrown weapons MIC, Baron Naran as target archery MIC, and Baroness Carrie Ann running the list. A&S competitions and classes are on the website. Help is needed for setup, starting Friday at noon. MOL table opens at 9.
- Midwinter's Revel: The site contract and check have been delivered. A&S scheduling is in progress. Mistress Arianna and Lady Eilionora will meet to discuss this.
- Night on the Town: The event is now on the kingdom calendar. Sir Hugh from Marinus will be feast steward. Lord Godwin will work on SCORES approval. event and target archery MICs are needed. Lady Eilionora will coordinate classes. Master Fearghus will be MIC for rapier combat archery, if it is needed.
- On Target: The barony is seeking stewards and staff.
